Strengthening New Mexico Agriculture

- USDA-inspected processing lets New Mexico ranchers sell meat directly into schools and public food programs
- Without local processing, many producers would have fewer opportunities to participate in the New Mexico Grown Program
- We buy livestock directly from New Mexico ranchers and the Roswell sale barn, then process it into boxed beef and pork for institutions statewide
- Every purchase keeps agricultural dollars circulating within New Mexico

Three refrigerated trucks deliver across New Mexico twice per month

Nearly 600,000 lbs of frozen storage — about 300 pallet spaces across three facilities
