REGIONAL COMMUNITY MEETINGS FEEDBACK SUMMARY

Overview

The Martinez/Yazzie regional community meetings, held August 5–27, 2025, gathered input to ensure the Martinez/Yazzie Action Plan reflects the needs of students, families, educators, and tribal communities across New Mexico. To ensure broad participation, food, childcare, and interpretation services were offered at every meeting. Additional engagement sessions were held with members of the Legislative Education Study Committee, deans and directors of New Mexico’s educator preparation programs, and tribal leadership, bringing together more than 40 leaders and officials from 19 Tribes, Nations, and Pueblos.

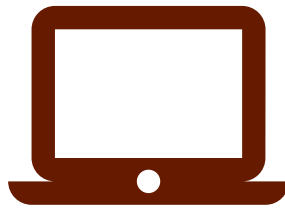

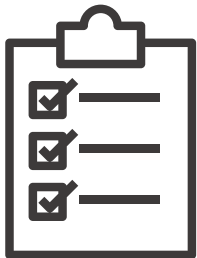
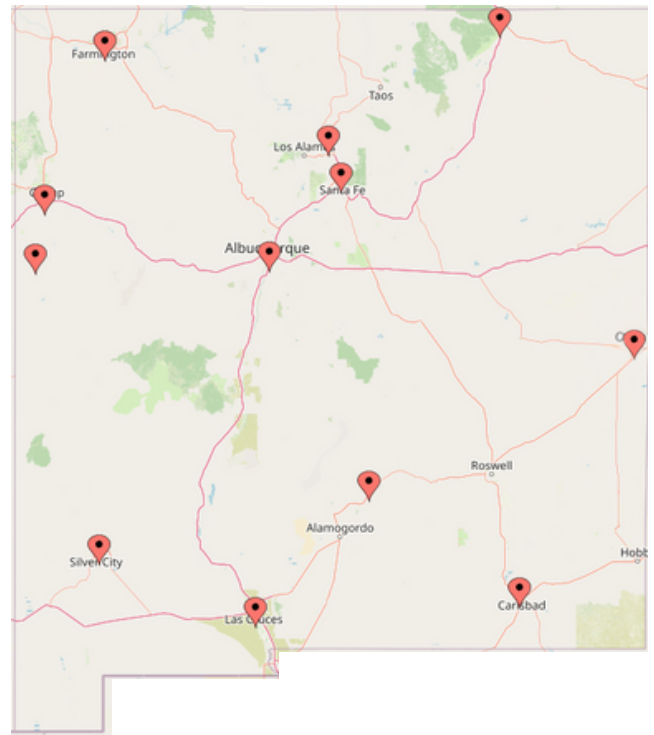
