

Sale of Livestock On/Off Reservation and Annual Transportation for 4H or Rodeos

- Chapter 7. Control and Inspection of Livestock
  - § 1258. Transportation of livestock, equine, animal, poultry and/or ratite by person without certificate of inspection or health certification or validated auction invoice; classification

#### **Required Documents**

- Proof of Ownership
  - o Bill of Sale
  - Navajo Grazing Permit
  - State Brand Card
  - Registration Paper
- Health Certificate
  - o Coggins
  - o 30-day Health Certificate



Steers - 2%



# Challenges when Investigating Missing Livestock

- > Collaboration with State Livestock Board positive.
- > Livestock Buyers do not renew their Annual Buyer's Permit through BIA.
- Most missing livestock are illegally sold off Reservation to private buyers and/or livestock buyers come onto Reservation without a valid permit.
  - Private Buyers buy livestock with written statements.
  - Most Private Buyers do not provide receipts or any sales documentations.
  - Private Buyers refuse to assist or provide names and other information.
  - Livestock Buyers are sometimes Ranchers and livestock cover a large area.
- Livestock are transported far away to other States from the Navajo Nation to be sold.

#### Possible Solutions: Cross Commissioning

- New Mexico State Law Enforcement Certification
- Ability to file with NM District Courts
- New Mexico Livestock Board Commission
- New Mexico Fish & Game Commission
- New Mexico Forestry Department Commission
- Auction Sale Yards to provide Sale Documentation.
