Transition Planning-Resource Re Entry Program

- Receiving Screening at booking
- Transition Planners begin engagement
- The Resource Re-entry Center (RRC) is the first stop for individuals released from the Metropolitan Detention Center as they reintegrate into the community.
- Once inmates are released to the RRC, community health workers assists these individuals to carry out their transition plans and connect them to services.





DBHS Supports for Clients at MDC Addiction Treatment Program


- Four-week, inpatient jail-based treatment program treating DWI offenders and offenders referred by the judicial system with addictions to alcohol and/or other drugs
- Community Reinforcement Approach
- One week of structured assessment by a licensed clinical staff member.
- Three weeks of curriculum designed to provide a solid base of knowledge and skills that can aid clients in their journey of recovery.

- Methadone Maintenance Program
- Methadone Induction Program
- Buprenorphine Maintenance Program
