## USDVA Highly Rural Transportation Grant (HRTG)

Grant funding is awarded to qualified organizations for providing services for veterans in highly rural areas who have difficulty getting VA health care due to the lack of transportation services.

Highly rural area is defined as a county with less than 7 people per square mile.

New Mexico has 15 qualifying counties.

Veterans are transported to VA and approved non-VA hospitals and clinics.



#### NMDVS HRTG Program

Received HRTG fall 2020; funding approved winter 2020; rides began early 2021.

Nine counties selected for a pilot program: Cibola, Colfax, Guadalupe, Harding, Mora, Quay, San Miguel, Socorro & Union.

<u>Funding breakdown</u>: funding per county ranges from approximately \$6,000 to \$15,000, totaling over \$102,000. Costs include mileage, advertising & administrative overhead.


Can be utilized for COVID-19 vaccination appointments with the VA.

11 completed rides covering two counties: Cibola & Union\* Each provider has pending rides for this month. \$81,851 remain in funding




#### **Current Operational Footprint**
