

## **Aviation Division Mandates**

- Authorize expenditures for construction, development and maintenance of public-use airport facilities
- Encourage and advance aviation in New Mexico

  EAA Air Venture, MRO Americas, AUVSI Expo, NBAA Convention, NASAO Art Contest, Aviation Day, Air Shows, Fly-Ins, Balloon Fiesta, private pilot recruitment initiatives
- Assemble and Distribute information relating to Aviation
- Responsible for the registration of all aircraft based in New Mexico and for the licensing of aircraft dealers
- Rural Air Service Enhancement
- Air Service Assistance Program (SUNSETS JUNE 30th, 2031)
- Provide a safe and effective aviation system plan





## **Aviation Division Functions**

- Provides planning and technical support in developing and maintaining the State's airports and other elements of the aviation system
- Coordinates with Federal and local governments for improvement of aviation infrastructure – Safety and Maintenance of pavements, navigational aids, other fixed assets and equipment
- Publish the New Mexico Aeronautical Chart
- Promulgates rules for enforcement of aviation laws
- Perform regulatory and compliance inspections FAA 5010 Airfield Safety Inspection






# New Mexico Airport System

50 - NPIAS (Eligible for FAA)

- 5 Non-NPIAS (NOT eligible for FAA)
- 4 Heliports
- 1 Sea Plane Base





# **State Aviation Funding**

- NMSA 1978, 7-1-6.7A 4.79% Specialty fuel for use in turboprop or jet-type engines
- NMSA 1978, 7-1-6.7B 0.26 % Gasoline Tax Act
- NMSA 1978, 7-1-6.7C 0.046 percent General Fund This stream sunsets June 30, 2031.
- NMSA 1978, 7-1-6.7D \$3,000,000 Annually from the General Fund
- NMSA 1978, 64-4-1 Aircraft Registration
  - A) Fee Schedule is multi-tiered based on the weight and age of the aircraft.
  - B) Revenue split 80/20 State and Local
  - C) Recommend elimination of "voluntary" registration statute
