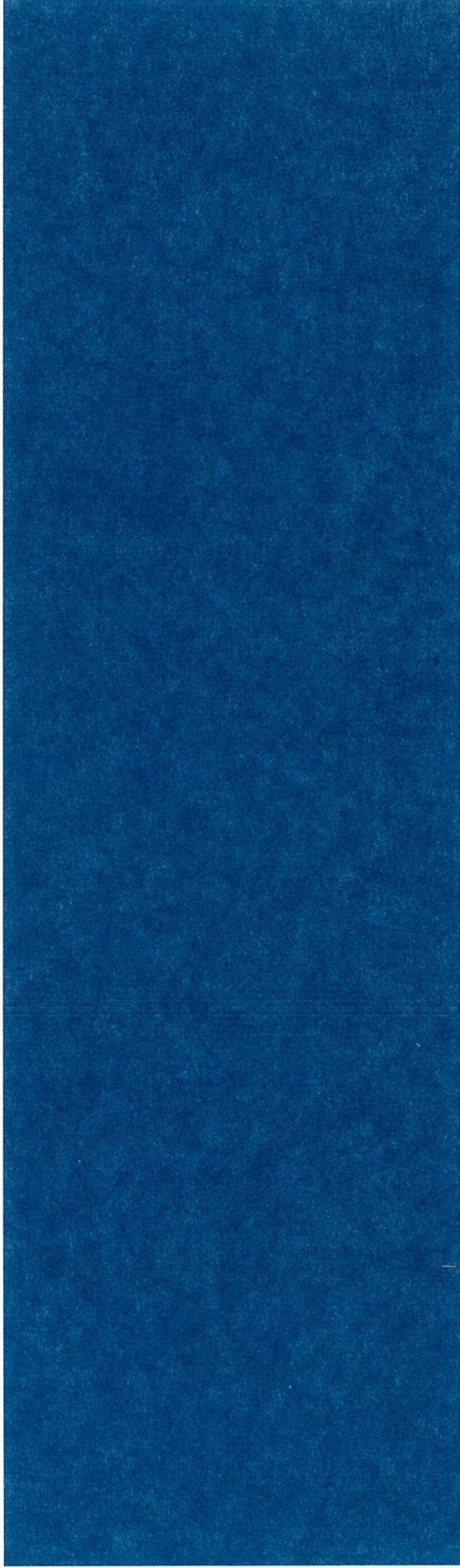

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT TRANSPORTATION PROJECT FUND

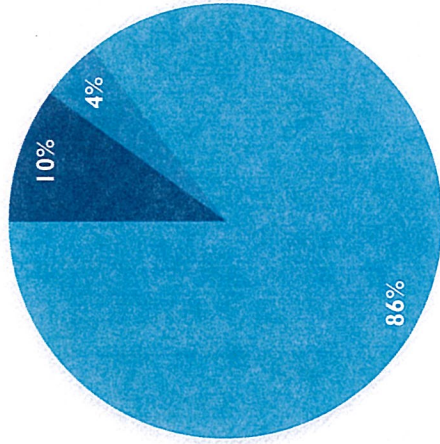
- Was created under House Bill 694 of the 2019 Legislative session to provide funds to Local entities for Transportation Infrastructure projects.
- Transportation infrastructure projects may consist of highways, streets, roadways, bridges, crossing structures and parking facilities, including all areas for vehicular use for travel, ingress, egress and parking and may include environmental and other studies, planning, design, construction and acquisition of rights of way.
- State Funding
  - 95% State Match
  - 5% Local Entity Match



# LGTPF DIVISION OF FUNDS

- \$50 million awarded for 2019
- \$5 million awarded to US 82
- \$2.25 million dedicated for Hardship Waiver
- \$42.75 million to distribute to Local Entities

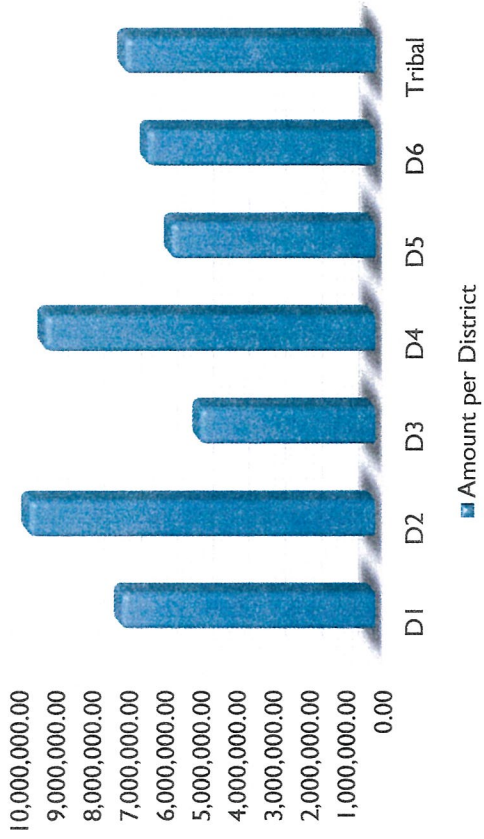
## APPLICATION PROCESS

- Call for projects sent out to MPO's and RTPO's in April
- MPO/RTPO's utilized RTIPER to select unfunded projects that were shovel ready
- Applications reviewed by district staff, ranked and submitted to the Project Oversight Division
- Applications were compiled and submitted to the Cabinet Secretary for review and recommendation
- Projects were selected by priority and ability to provide complete funding

# 2019 DATA

- 166 applications received for 2019
- 57 projects selected to award funding
- Total of \$42.4 million awarded to districts
- \$6.9 million awarded to Tribal entities

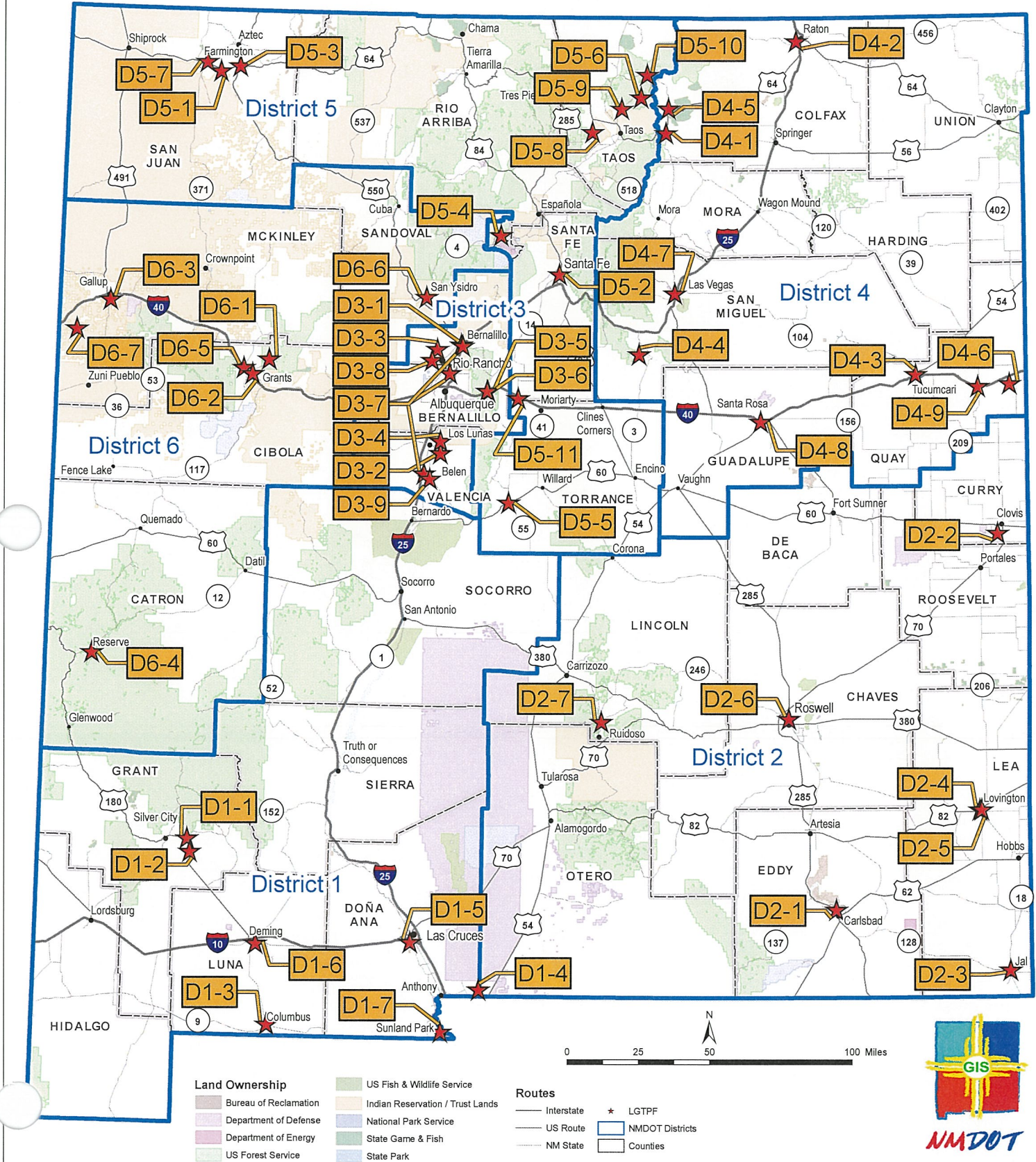

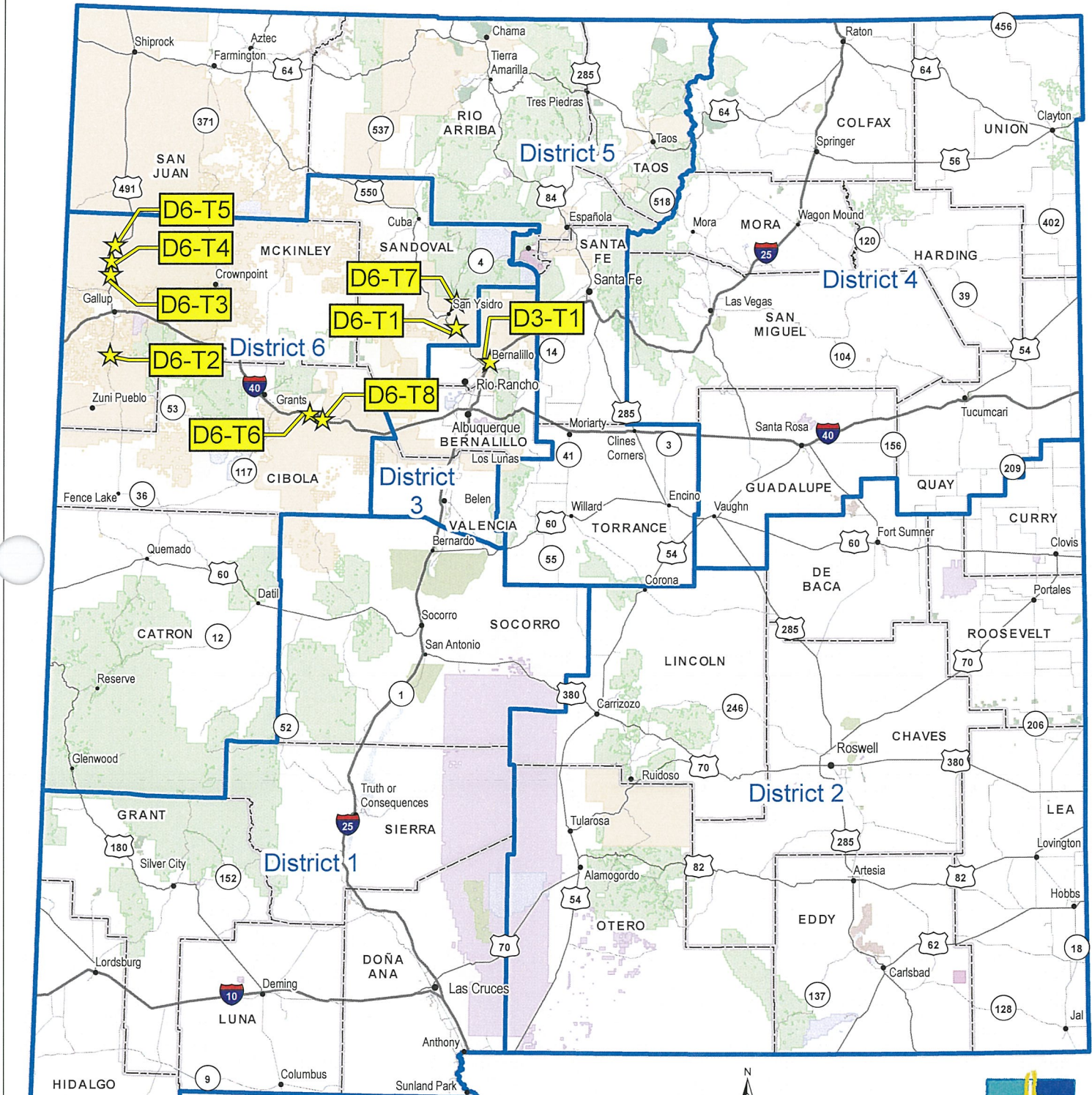


# LGTPF Locations
