


TIRS-August 2019 NMDOT District Three



District Three is located in Central New Mexico and encompasses Bernalillo, Valencia and portions of Sandoval County. Though the smallest geographically, District Three currently serves a population in excess of 910,000 which is projected to top 1,108,000 by 2040. Within the boundaries are sixteen (16) communities and eight (8) Tribal Governments. District Three is located at 7500 Pan American Freeway NE, Albuquerque, NM.
