Updates on Transportation and Road Issues in Artesia, NM

- 1. Request to install a traffic signal at 285 and Mill Rd.
 - The City has established a warrant for this intersection based on the Multi-Way Stop & Signal Warrant Analysis of January 2011.
- 2. Rehabilitation of the inside lanes of Main St. from 7^{th} to 13^{th} St (pictured on the Bac-k)
 - The road in this area is showing road failure and severe fatigue cracking.
 - •Request to replace or upgrade the traffic signal at 7th and Main St. This is the second oldest traffic signal in the community and has had a repetitive history of failure in the last five years.
 - •Request to install ADA Ramps and a crosswalk for the community.
- The City would like to request replacement or upgrade of the traffic signal on 20th and Main St.
 - This is the oldest traffic signal in the community and has also had a repetitive history of failure in the last 5 years.
- 4. Rehabilitation of 285 (1st St.) and Main St. (pictured on the back)
 - •Heavy road traffic in the area has caused the intersection to experience severe rutting, especially in the Northbound section of 285.
- 5. Intersection of Mill Rd and 285 (1st St.)
 - The City would like to request a deceleration lane for Northbound traffic for a leftturning lane hold and queue.
 - Due to the existence of a business at the intersection, the left-turn holding queue was overlooked or not installed which causes a safety risk to the public driving on 285.
