■ The University of New Mexico is the only tertiary pediatric oncology center in the state of New Mexico providing comprehensive clinical care

We strive to provide the most up-to-date cancer treatments to children and young adults across the state of New Mexico

Children's Oncology Group

- National Cancer Institute supported clinical trials consortium
- Devoted to childhood and adolescent cancer research
- More than 10,000 members at more than 200 hospitals in North America, Europe, Australia and New Zealand.
- 90% of children diagnosed with cancer in the United States are cared for at COG institutions

Through COG and similar research groups we have improved the survival of children with cancer from 10%, 50 years ago to a combined 5-year survival rate of 80% today.



Children's Oncology Group

- Offering the most up-to-date, clinical trials and cutting edge research
 - Targeted therapies
 - Precision medicine approach to cancer treatment
 - Decreasing toxicities and long term side effects
- Keeping New Mexico families close to home
 - ~100 newly diagnosed patients per year
 - ~70 seen at UNM Pediatric Oncology





COG Pediatric Research Trials at UNM

- Currently: 20 open clinical trials
 - 12 therapeutic trials
 - Leukemia: ALL, AML, Relapsed
 - High Risk Neuroblastoma
 - Low Grade Glioma
 - Standard Risk Germ Cell Tumors
 - Hepatic Malignancy
 - High Grade Glioma
- High Priority Pending Trials: 7
- Second Tier Trials To Open: 10
 - High Grade Glioma
 - Relapsed Hodgkin Lymphoma
 - Rhabdomyosarcoma
 - Relapsed Leukemia

UNM Pediatric Oncology Enrollments

- July 2021- September 15th, 2021
 - 15 new diagnoses to date
 - 100% of patients approached for clinical trials
 - 7 patients enrolled, 2 declined due to religious reasons, 6 pending
 - 5 patients eligible for therapeutic trial
 - 5 patients enrolled on therapeutic trial

Development of New Programs to Meet the Needs of New Mexico

- Cancer Predisposition Clinic
 - Only program in the state
 - Partnered with Genetics
- Vascular Lesion Clinic
 - Multidisciplinary clinic
- Pediatric Oncology Focused Palliative Care
 - Focused on the specific needs of our patient population
- Survivorship Clinic
 - Rapidly growing cancer survivor population

Research Initiatives

 Collaboration with Boston Children's and St. Jude Children's Research Hospital to evaluate clinical trial enrollment practices among minority patients

 Collaboration with New Mexico Tumor Registry and Department of Epidemiology to characterize pediatric cancers in New Mexico from 1980-2019

National publications in scientific research journals

Future Goals

- Increasing support for Division of Pediatric Oncology
 - Genetic Counselor
 - Faculty
 - Increased clinical support for families and patients
- Expansion of clinical trials available for patients
