Senator Soules discussed legislation (.221152.2) that would create a research grants closing fund with an initial appropriation of \$40 million. Senator Soules requested endorsement by the committee and a motion was made and approved on a five-to-one vote to endorse this legislation.

Representative Sariñana discussed legislation (.221312.2) that would create the energy storage system income tax credit. Representative Sariñana requested endorsement by the committee and a motion was made and approved on a five-to-one vote to endorse this legislation.
