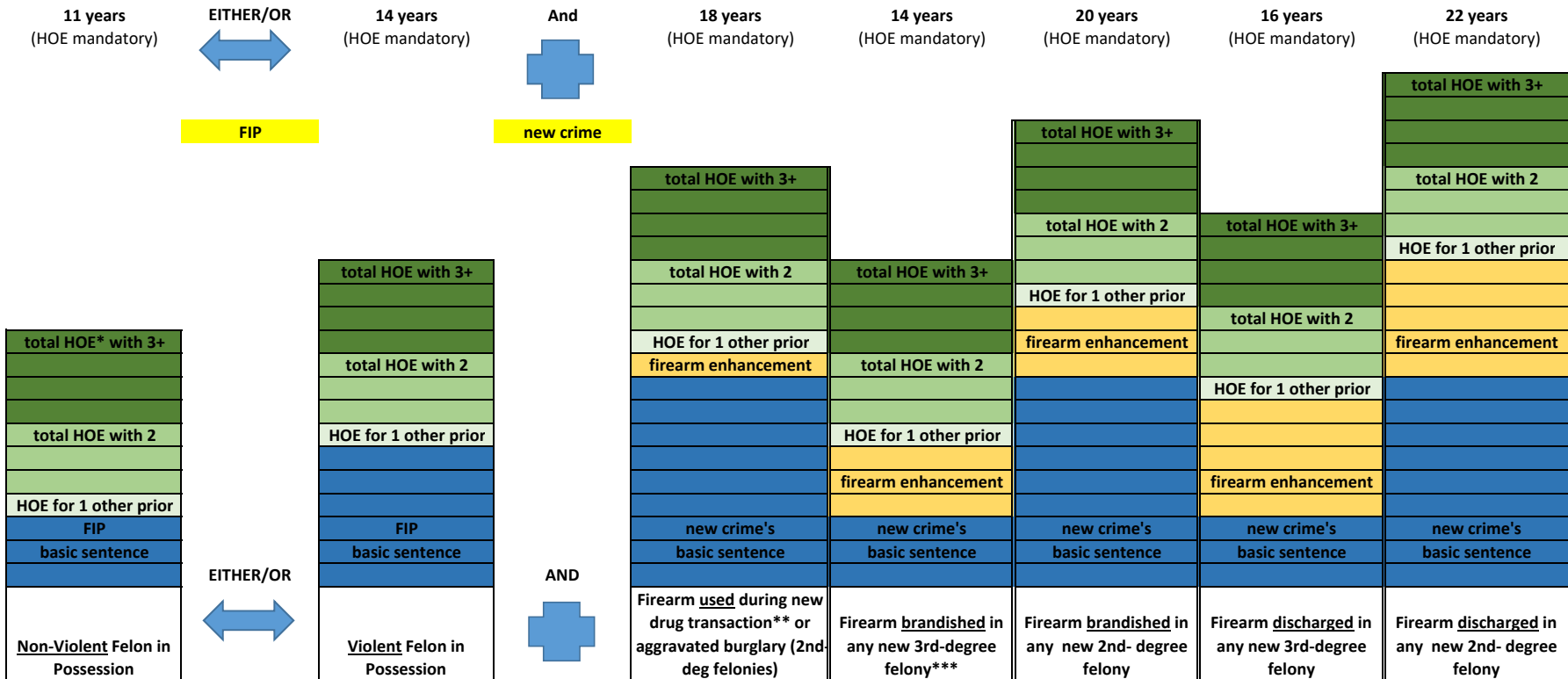


Felon in Possession ("FIP") does not require use.

Under current law, if a convicted felon commits a new crime involving a gun, they are facing the following penalties:



* HOE: habitual offender enhancement

** if trafficking is a second offense, the basic sentence is 18 years, not 9

*** 2nd and 3rd-degree felonies are the most common firearm crimes, but if the new crime is a 4th- or 1st-degree felony, the basic sentence would be 1.5 or 18 years, respectively
