

Cannabis Revenue Update

Between April 1, 2022, and May 31, 2025, New Mexico cannabis retailers sold approximately \$1.7 billion in adult-use and medical cannabis combined.

Medical: Approximately \$503 million

Adult-Use: Approximately \$1.2 billion
