### Programs to Build Homeownership and Wealth

#### FirstHome

An affordable mortgage loan option for first-time homebuyers. Provides below market interest rates. Funded by issuance of taxexempt mortgage revenue bonds.

#### FirstDown

Available to first-time homebuyers. An amortizing down payment assistance, second mortgage program with monthly payments that must be combined with FirstHome. Loan amount is 4% of purchase price and is funded by Housing New Mexico General Fund.

#### **FirstDown Plus**

A third mortgage down payment assistance loan designed to provide additional down payment to first time homebuyers qualified to use the FirstHome program. Loan is \$10,000 amortizing over 15 years at 0% interest rate. Funded by NM Housing Trust Fund.





### Programs to Build Homeownership and Wealth

#### HomeForward

A recently updated first mortgage loan option for non-firsttime homebuyers. Funded through TBA mortgage market.

#### HomeForward DPA

A 10 or 15 year, amortizing down payment assistance program, second mortgage with monthly payments that must be combined with HomeForward. Loan amount is 3% of sales price. Funded through NM Housing Trust Fund.

#### Partners

MFA purchases first time homebuyer loans originated by Habitat for in New Mexico. Funded through Housing New Mexico's General Fund.
