AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIME; REVISING PENALTIES FOR CERTAIN OFFENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 66-5-30 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 252, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-5-30. AUTHORITY OF DIVISION TO SUSPEND OR REVOKE LICENSE.--

A. The division may suspend the instruction permit, driver's license or provisional license of a driver without preliminary hearing upon a showing by its records or other sufficient evidence, including information provided to the state pursuant to an intergovernmental agreement authorized by Section 66-5-27.1 NMSA 1978, that the licensee:

(1) has been convicted of an offense for which mandatory revocation of license is required upon conviction;

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1 (2) has been convicted as a driver in an
2 accident resulting in the death or personal injury of another
3 or serious property damage;

4 (3) has been convicted with such frequency of
5 offenses against traffic laws or rules governing motor vehicles
6 as to indicate a disrespect for traffic laws and a disregard
7 for the safety of other persons on the highways;

8 (4) is an habitually reckless or negligent
9 driver of a motor vehicle;

10 (5) is incompetent to drive a motor vehicle;

11 (6) has permitted an unlawful or fraudulent
12 use of the license;

13 (7) has been convicted of an offense in
14 another state or tribal jurisdiction that if committed within
15 this state's jurisdiction would be grounds for suspension or
16 revocation of the license;

17 (8) has violated provisions stipulated by a
18 district court in limitation of certain driving privileges;

19 ~~[(9) has failed to fulfill a signed promise to~~
20 ~~appear or notice to appear in court as evidenced by notice from~~
21 ~~a state court or tribal court, whenever appearance is required~~
22 ~~by law or by the court as a consequence of a charge or~~
23 ~~conviction under the Motor Vehicle Code or pursuant to the laws~~
24 ~~of the tribe;~~

25 ~~(10) has failed to pay a penalty assessment~~

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1 ~~within thirty days of the date of issuance by the state or a~~
2 ~~tribe; or~~

3 ~~(11)]~~ (9) has accumulated seven points, but
4 less than eleven points, and when the division has received a
5 recommendation from a municipal or magistrate judge that the
6 license be suspended for a period not to exceed three months;
7 or

8 (10) has failed to comply with the terms of a
9 citation issued in a foreign jurisdiction that is a party to
10 the Nonresident Violator Compact and that has notified the
11 department of the failure in accordance with the Nonresident
12 Violator Compact.

13 B. If a person whose license was issued by a
14 jurisdiction outside New Mexico that is a party to the
15 Nonresident Violator Compact fails to comply with the terms of
16 a citation issued in New Mexico, the department shall notify
17 that other jurisdiction of the failure and that jurisdiction
18 shall initiate a license suspension action in accordance with
19 the provisions of Article IV of the Nonresident Violator
20 Compact.

21 ~~[B-]~~ C. Upon suspending the license of a person as
22 authorized in this section, the division shall immediately
23 notify the licensee in writing of the licensee's right to a
24 hearing before the administrative hearings office and, upon the
25 licensee's request, shall notify the administrative hearings

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1 office. The administrative hearings office shall schedule the
2 hearing to take place as early as practicable, but within no
3 more than twenty days, not counting Saturdays, Sundays and
4 legal holidays after receipt of the request. The hearing shall
5 be held in the county in which the licensee resides unless the
6 hearing officer and the licensee agree that the hearing may be
7 held in some other county; provided that the hearing request is
8 received within twenty days from the date that the suspension
9 was deposited in the United States mail. The hearing officer
10 may, in the hearing officer's discretion, extend the twenty-day
11 period. The hearing shall be held as provided in the
12 Administrative Hearings Office Act. After the hearing, the
13 hearing officer shall either rescind the order of suspension or
14 continue, modify or extend the suspension of the license or
15 revoke the license."

16 SECTION 2. Section 66-5-39 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,
17 Chapter 35, Section 261, as amended) is amended to read:

18 "66-5-39. DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED--PENALTIES.--

19 A. ~~[Any]~~ A person who drives a motor vehicle on any
20 public highway of this state at a time when the person's
21 privilege to do so is suspended and who knows or should have
22 known that the person's license was suspended is guilty of a
23 misdemeanor and ~~[shall be charged with a violation of this~~
24 ~~section. Upon conviction, the person shall]~~ may be punished,
25 notwithstanding the provisions of Section ~~[31-18-13]~~ 31-19-1

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1 NMSA 1978, by imprisonment for not [~~less than four days or~~
2 more than [~~three hundred sixty-four~~] ninety days or
3 participation for an equivalent period of time in a certified
4 alternative sentencing program, [~~and there may be imposed in~~
5 ~~addition~~] or by payment of a fine of not more than [~~one~~
6 ~~thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~] three hundred dollars (\$300), or
7 both. When a person pays any or all of the cost of
8 participating in a certified alternative sentencing program,
9 the court may apply that payment as a deduction to any fine
10 imposed by the court. Any municipal ordinance prohibiting
11 driving with a suspended license shall provide penalties no
12 less stringent than provided in this section.

13 B. In addition to any other penalties imposed
14 pursuant to the provisions of this section, when a person is
15 convicted pursuant to the provisions of this section or a
16 municipal ordinance that prohibits driving on a suspended
17 license, the motor vehicle the person was driving may be
18 immobilized by an immobilization device for thirty days, unless
19 immobilization of the motor vehicle poses an imminent danger to
20 the health, safety or employment of the convicted person's
21 immediate family or the family of the owner of the motor
22 vehicle. The convicted person shall bear the cost of
23 immobilizing the motor vehicle.

2 SECTION 3. Section 66-8-116 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,
3 Chapter 35, Section 524, as amended) is amended to read:

4 "66-8-116. PENALTY ASSESSMENT MISDEMEANORS--DEFINITION--
5 SCHEDULE OF ASSESSMENTS.--

6 A. As used in the Motor Vehicle Code and the Boat
7 Act, "penalty assessment misdemeanor" means violation of any of
8 the following listed sections of the NMSA 1978 for which,
9 except as provided in Subsections D through F of this section,
10 the listed penalty assessment is established:

11 B. The term "penalty assessment misdemeanor" does
12 not include a violation that has caused or contributed to the
13 cause of an accident resulting in injury or death to a person.

14 C. When an alleged violator of a penalty assessment
15 misdemeanor elects to accept a notice to appear in lieu of a
16 notice of penalty assessment, a fine imposed upon later
17 conviction shall not exceed the penalty assessment established
18 for the particular penalty assessment misdemeanor and probation
19 imposed upon a suspended or deferred sentence shall not exceed
20 ninety days.

21 D. The penalty assessment for speeding in violation
22 of Paragraph (5) of Subsection A of Section 66-7-301 NMSA 1978
23 is twice the penalty assessment established in Subsection A of
24 this section for the equivalent miles per hour over the speed
25 limit.

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1 E. Upon a second conviction for operation without a
2 permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Section
3 66-7-413 NMSA 1978, the penalty assessment shall be two hundred
4 fifty dollars (\$250). Upon a third or subsequent conviction,
5 the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500).

6 F. Upon a second conviction for transport of a
7 reducible load with a permit for excessive size or weight
8 pursuant to Subsection N of Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978 more
9 than six miles from a port-of-entry facility on the border with
10 Mexico, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars
11 (\$500). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty
12 assessment shall be one thousand dollars (\$1,000)."

13 SECTION 4. Section 66-8-126 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,
14 Chapter 35, Section 534) is amended to read:

15 "66-8-126. FAILURE TO OBEY NOTICE TO APPEAR.--

16 A. It is a penalty assessment misdemeanor for [~~any~~]
17 a person to violate [~~his~~] that person's written promise to
18 appear in court given to an officer upon issuance of a uniform
19 traffic citation regardless of the disposition of the charge
20 for which the citation was issued.

21 B. A written promise to appear in court may be
22 complied with by appearance of counsel."

23 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
24 provisions of this act is July 1, 2019.
