Highlights of Accomplishments - Technology

- \$1.8 million across three phases of electronic access and surveillance system
- \$900 thousand in IT server and router replacements and upgrades
- \$1.9 million in Wi-Fi upgrades, hyperconverged data center, virtual desktop upgrades, firewall upgrades, network switch upgrades, new servers and disaster recovery system.
- Migrated from Unidata to Sequential Query Language (SQL).

- 225 laptops, 62 hotspots were loans to students and 7 Wi-Fi points were installed.
- Collaborative for Higher Education Shared Services (CHESS) implementing an Enterprise Resources Planning (ERP) system and Student Information System (SIS).
- Nearly 2200 desktop and laptop pc's purchased and installed to keep "fleet" current.



Funding

- Strategic tuition rate policy was approved by trustees for systematic adjustment of tuition rates based on economic factors.
- Student Health Center: Provides medical and mental health care and support: \$2,200,000.
- HEERF Funding: \$23,496,267
- Welding program area renovations
- New entrances, improved roadway, parking lots and paving




