THREE DAY TRIP TO WASHINGTON DC

TULAROSA BASIN DOWNWINDERS CONSORTIUM CONTINUES TO SEEK TO HAVE NEW MEXICO INCUDED IN RECA

NEW MEXICO IS A STATE OF PATRIOTS INCLUDING THE HEROES OF THE BATAAN DEATH MARCH AND NAVAJO CODE TALKERS.

MORE NEW MEXICANS SERVED IN WWII THAN ANY OTHER STATE.

WE HAVE SIX MILITARY INSTALLATIONS INCLUDING ONE OF THE LARGEST LAND BASES IN THE WORLD; WHITE SANDS MISSILE RANGE

- SEPTEMBER 24 TO 26 MEMBERS OF NAVAJO AND OTHER RADIATION, URANIUM MINE SURVIVORS AND DOWNWINDERS DEMAND ACTION ON STALLED RECA PROGRAM.
- DAY ONE STARTED WITH BREAKFAST HOSTED BY THE NAVAJO NATION DC OFFICE AND A PRESS CONFERENCE HOSTED BY BUU NIGREN, NAVAJO PRESIDENT.
- MARCH THROUGH THE STREETS TO CAPITOL HILL; DRUMMING AND CHANTING; THE MARCH WAS JOINED BY BUU NIGREN AND STAFF.
- THERE WAS A VERY HIGHLY ATTENDED PRESS CONFERENCE WHERE MEMBERS OF CONGRESS AND ADVOCATES SPOKE.
- OVER 40 UNIQUE MEDIA STORIES COVERING THE THREE DAYS OF EVENTS!!
- PERFORMANCES AND DRUMMING BY THE DINE TAH DANCERS.
- MARCH TO SPEAKER MIKE JOHNSON'S OFFICE TO PRESENT THE LETTER FROM THE RADIOACTIVE AND
 HAZARDOUS MATERIALS COMMITTEE THE LETTER WAS HIGHLY REGARDED. WE ALSO PRESENTED INVOICES.
 THE TOTAL ESTIMATE OF MEDICAL COSTS FROM ALL OF THE BILLS PEOPLE FILLED OUT WAS OVER \$7 MILLION
 FROM PROTESTERS PRESENT.
- CANDLELIGHT VIGIL IN FRONT OF THE US CAPITOL BUILDING.
- CULTURAL PRAYERS, SINGING, AND CHANTING IN FRONT OF THE CAPITOL.



POTENTIAL COMPROMISE

- DURING THE THREE DAY TRIP MEETINGS WERE HELD WITH ABOUT A DOZEN MEMBERS OF CONGRESS, INCLUDING THE HOUSE MAJORITY WHIP AND THE ENTIRE UTAH HOUSE DELEGATION.
- THE PUSH BACK FROM A HANDFUL OF LEGISLATORS, PRIMARILY UTAH, IS STILL COST.
- A COMPROMISE CAP IS BEING DISCUSSED. THE CAP WOULD SUNSET THE PROGRAM IN 5 OR 6 YEARS OR WHEN \$5 BILLION IS PAIDOUT, WHICHEVER IS REACHED FIRST.
- THIS LOOKS LIKE A GOOD COMPROMISE BECAUSE IN 33 YEARS ONLY \$2.5 BILLION HAS BEEN PAID TO THOSE ELIGIBLE.

- VERY POSITIVE MEETING WITH REP. CELESTE MALOY FROM UTAH, WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY SEEMED VERY OPPOSED TO OUR BILL, BUT NOW IS MUCH MORE RECEPTIVE TO EXPANDING THE PROGRAM. THIS COULD BE VERY HELPFUL IN FLIPPING THE UTAH DELEGATION AND REMOVING A MAJOR OBSTACLE.
- ICT POLITICAL NEWS REPORTED THE FOLLOWING: REPUBLICAN REP. TOM COLE, CHICKASAW, FROM OKLAHOMA TOLD ICT HE WOULD URGE REPUBLICAN HOUSE SPEAKER MIKE JOHNSON FROM LOUISIANA TO HOLD A VOTE FOR THE ACT. "I THINK THOSE THINGS OUGHT TO COME TO THE FLOOR AND LET THE HOUSE WORK ITS WILL." THE REPRESENTATIVE ADDED, "HARM WAS DONE AND APPROPRIATE COMPENSATION NEEDS TO BE RENDERED," HINTING AT SUPPORT FOR THE EXPANDED BILL." THIS IS HUGE, SINCE REP COLE IS THE HEAD OF THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE AND HAS A LOT OF POWER TO BRING OUR BILL FORWARD.
- REPORTING FROM STATES NEWSROOM LISTED RECA AS ONE OF THE "UNFINISHED BUSINESS" ITEMS FOR CONGRESS TO ADDRESS BEFORE THE END OF THE YEAR, DURING THE LAME DUCK SESSION. THIS WAS THE GOAL FOR THIS EVENT MAKE SURE THAT CONGRESS DOES NOT FORGET ABOUT THE ISSUE AND TEE IT UP TO BE PASSED IN THE LAME DUCK
- AFTER THE TRIP, TINA CORDOVA AND TWO OTHER DOWNWINDERS MET WITH HAKEEM JEFFRIES, HOUSE MAJORITY LEADER WHO SAID "I'M WITH YOU UNTIL WE GET THIS DONE; UNTIL WE GET THIS DONE." HE PLEDGED THAT SB 3853 WOULD BE A PRIORITY IN NEGOTIATIONS WITH SPEAKER MIKE JOHNSON.


