

What Did We Learn?


The Early College High School Model graduates students at near 100%

- o Eliminates gaps in demographic groups
- Most earn associates degrees and/or certifications along with their diploma
- Places them at an average \$5,000-\$12,000 economic advantage over their non-ECHS peers

Best Practices

- Finding out they CAN do college as early as 9th grade is life-changing
- o Pathways connected to career destinations
- Students learn responsibility and self-motivation early


Doña County Population in Poverty According to KidsCount Data








Lifetime Incomes by Education Level






