

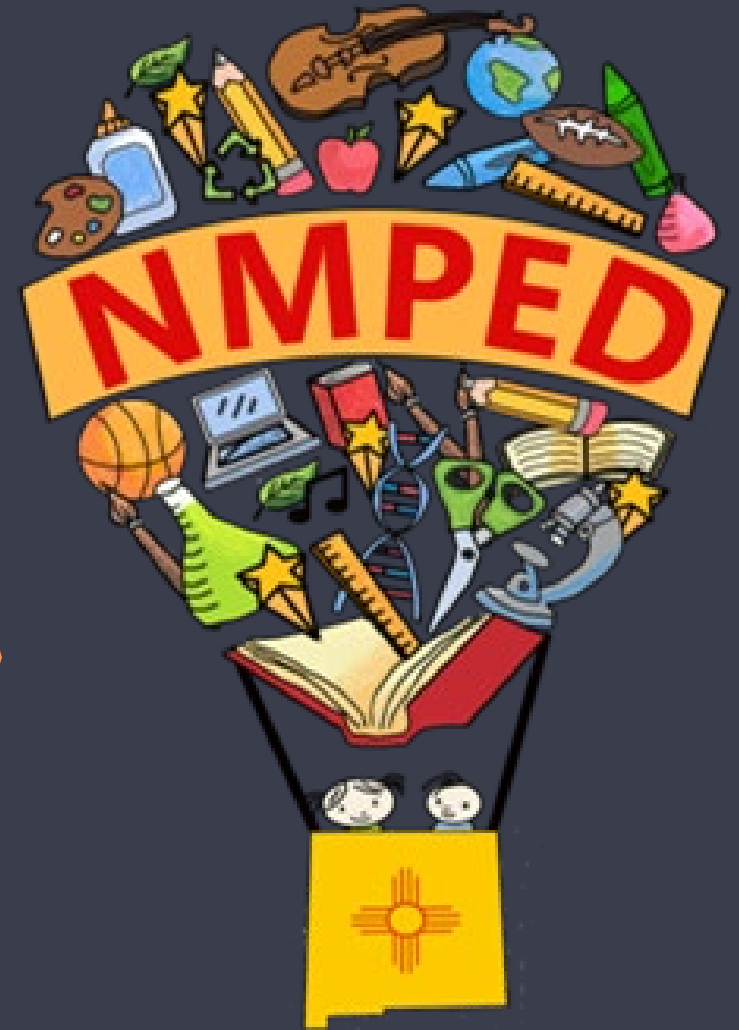

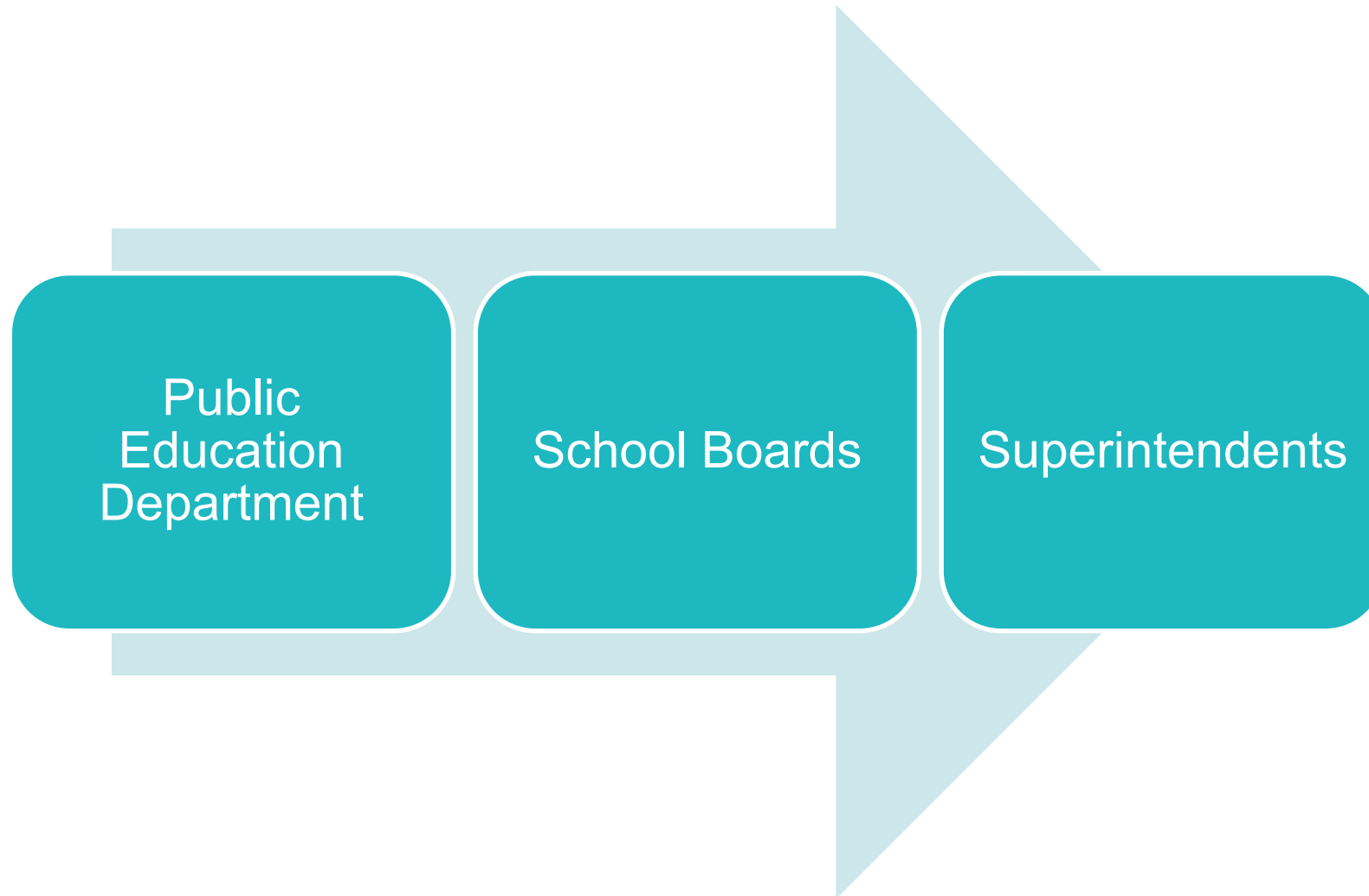


Accountability in Action

Agency Governance and School Boards

- Section 22-5-13 NMSA 1978
 - In statute, PED is given authority for school board member training to include:
 - ✓ PED rules
 - ✓ PED policy and procedures
 - ✓ Statutory powers and duties of local school boards
 - ✓ Legal concepts pertaining to public schools
 - ✓ Finance and budget
- 6.29.1 NMAC
 - NMSBA provides training and support

Potential Policy Needs and Resources



Greater specificity in statute for removal of individual school board members



Prohibitions for banned members such as barring them from re-election



Add additional members to school boards



Funding to develop superintendent and school board leaders
