RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TEACHER RECRUITMENT/RETENTION

- Remove unnecessary barriers to licensure (Increased NES Standards)
- Create an incentive program for students interested in pursuing careers in education. (College scholarships with NM work requirement)
- 3. Support teacher pipeline programs like Educators Rising NM, EA's to Teachers, Second Career programs etc.
- 4. Compensate teachers at a salary level comparable to neighboring states.
- 5. Work with EPP programs to streamline licensure requirements.
