# **Uranium Mine Site Reclamation Quarterly Report**

Fiscal Year 2026 Q1: July - September 2025

House Bill 2 (2025 Legislative Session) authorized the New Mexico Legislative Appropriation for FY 26 for multimedia environmental investigations, clean-up, and related tasks at various neglected uranium mining sites. Clean up activity in the Grants Uranium Mining District represents a collaborative effort between NMED's Office of Strategic Initiatives and EMNRD's Mining Act Reclamation Program (MARP) and Abandoned Mine Lands (AML) Program\*. A total of six firms were selected in a competitive process to clean up mines: EA, ENTACT, INTERA, Tetra Tech, ERRG-LATA Joint Venture, and Parsons Transportation Group.
