State Land Office Legal Framework

- Fiduciary responsibility to manage state trust lands to protect trust assets (e.g., land) and keeps them productive and healthy for current and future generations
- Commissioner maintains broad authority over state trust lands, subject to limitations prescribed in federal and state law
- Leases include terms and conditions entities must follow as a matter of contract in addition to regulatory requirements (OCD, NMED, etc.) and NMSLO rules
- Enforcement tools achieve compliance via collaboration or litigation (no general authority to issue fines)


- Lease and regulatory compliance

Sanmal Queen Unit: Smith & Marrs / MMCP Leasing Lawsuit (\$7.5 million Damage Judgment)



Remediation & Reclamation Efforts



Created New Environmental Compliance Office

- Added three environmental specialists in 2023
- Stepped-up R&R, greater expertise



Enforcement & Accountability Program

- 746 oil & gas wells plugged (at industry's expense) since Nov. 2020
- Over \$70 million R&R costs NOT shouldered by taxpayers
- 38 lawsuits filed (20 active, 18 successfully resolved)



Bonding

- Ensure all leases are bonded
- Protect taxpayers and land trust beneficiaries (school kids)


