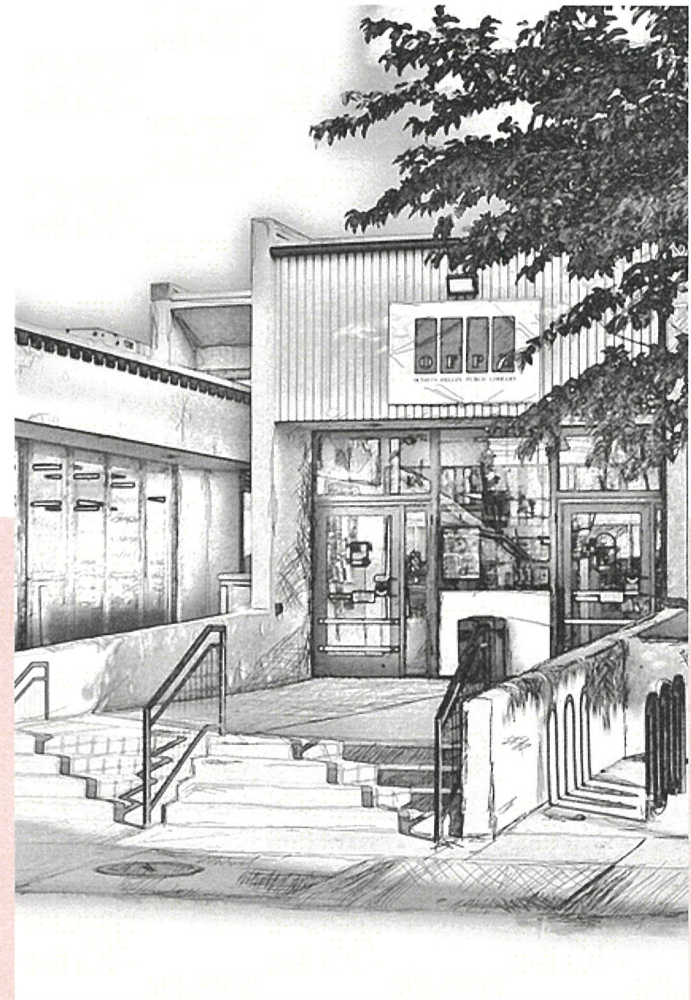

What is now known as the Rex Museum located at 300 West Historic Route 66, was part of the original Gallup Townsite, surveyed and platted by Alex Bowie, a surveyor for the Calcedonia Coal Co. The building was constructed by Italian Stonemasons of locally quarried sandstone in the Stone Commercial Style, a regional variation of the Brick Commercial Style. The original stone cornice contains a dentile masonry design. As with other early hotels, the first floor was used for commercial space while the guest rooms occupied the second floor. In its later years, the hotel population included "ladies of the night" and their guests. The museum building host local and traveling exhibits.

The 1928 El Morro Theater is the only example of Spanish Colonial Revival architecture in Gallup. It was designed by Carl Boller of the Boller Brothers architecture firm of Los Angeles and Kansas City. The Boller Brothers firm was responsible for designing many theaters in the Southwest, Midwest and California. Once described as a "castle of pleasure and art", the El Morro occupies a prominent location on Coal Avenue and has been the backdrop to many Indian Tribal Ceremonial parades.

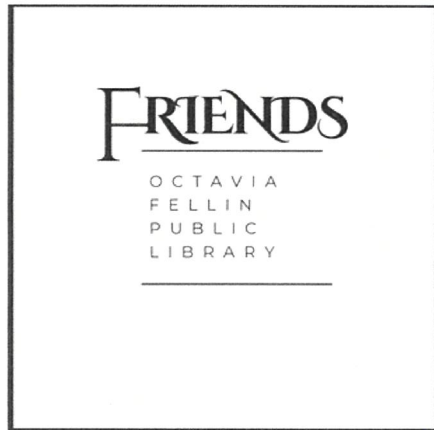

Adult Library Cards

Neighbors 18 years of age and older can request a library card in person, over the phone, or online.

Must provide the following:

- Valid State Driver's License, State ID, Military ID, or Passport
- Valid mailing address and physical address

Child & Youth Cards

Neighbors 5-17 years of age are eligible for the child & youth card. A legal guardian must complete the online form providing their ID, valid mailing & physical address and agree to the terms and conditions.

Out-of-County Cards

Persons living outside McKinley County or out-of-state can request a library card using the same website as above. Out-of-county membership fees are an annual charge of \$20.00.

Educator Cards

Educators can request an educator card in addition to a regular card. You need your school ID, contract, or paystub. See teacher loan card policy for details.

Borrowing Guidelines

- Library cards are required when borrowing materials
- Neighbors can borrow 30 circulating items at one time with a library account in good standing
- Music CDs & DVDs are restricted to 10 items at a time and can only be checked out with an adult card
- All Materials can be borrowed for five (5) weeks
- Return all library materials to the outside book drop or inside the library during business hours

Library materials can be renewed

- In-person.
- By phone with the library card number
- Through the library system with a PIN.
- Items may not be renewed if they are on hold or if the account is not in good standing.

Reserves (Holds)

- Any circulating library material can be placed on hold directly in the catalog.
- Reserves are kept at the front desk for three (3) business days excluding holidays and weekends.

In-House Use Only

Magazines, Newspapers, Locked Case (LC), Reference (R), and Microfilm are non-circulating. Please ask an OFPL team member for help with accessing these materials.

Other Resources

New Mexico Family Pass

Provides free admission for up to six people to any of New Mexico's Department of Cultural Affairs museums and historic sites. Check the Family Pass out for free at the front desk of either library location.

OFPL - Seed Library

A depository of seeds is available to all community members at no cost. Watch for OFPL programs that provide information, instruction, and education about sustainable botany for our region.

Customized -Book Bundle

Looking for your next great read/watch/listen? OFPL creates a bundle of materials, curated just for you! Let us know what your interests are and a collection development specialist will create a custom bundle of materials to pick up through our curbside services or during public access hours.

Charging Station

OFPL provides courtesy charging stations while you browse the library and use our services. There are six charging lockers with two charging cables per locker. Simply enter a 4-digit combination to secure your personal electronic device. Re-enter the combination to remove your device.

Fines

Any money owed including fines and fees will result in a blocked account until the balance is paid in full.

Overdue fines are listed below.

- DVDs \$1.00 per day
- Books are fine free

Lost or Damaged Materials

The replacement cost for lost or damaged items is full price plus a \$10.00 processing fee per item

Inter-Library Loan (ILL)

Requests for materials the library does not own can be made online or with the front desk. Items are borrowed from another library. The due date is determined by the lending library. ILL materials cannot be renewed. Late materials will be fined based on the lending library's charges for late items.

Shipping fees are charged for ILLs not picked up.

Computer, Printing, Scanning, & Copier Usage

- Public access computers and Wi-Fi available at both library locations
- 10 complimentary printed or scanned pages per day
- Wireless printing services are available for in-library use or curbside pickup.

Ask staff at the front desk for more information.

Outdoor To-Go Lockers

OFPL provides outdoor lockers located just outside the main Library. Place a curbside request through our web-based catalog, <https://ofpl.online>. Allow 48 business hours for processing. Curbside requests are placed in a locker accessible only with your library card.
