



Executive Overview of Abandoned Uranium Mine and other Neglected Contaminated Site Clean-up Actions funded by \$20,000,000 Legislative Appropriation

Uranium Mine Reclamation

- \$6,500,000 – Reclamation of the Moe #4 Mine; Schmidt Decline and Red Bluff #1 mines will also be done if funding allows.
- \$2,500,000 – Reimbursement of expenditures by EMNRD's Abandoned Mine Land Program.
- \$2,400,000 – Begin initial cleanups of 20 additional sites previously prioritized.
- \$540,000 – Contractual services for implementation plan and site inventory of mines.
- \$60,000 – EMNRD Mining Act Reclamation Program for uranium site assessments.

Sub-total: \$12,000,000

Groundwater Quality Bureau – Neglected Contaminate Site Cleanups

- \$5,000,000-Tucumcari Truck Stop Site.
- \$1,000,000- Aerex Refinery Site in Bloomfield, NM.

Sub-total: \$7,000,000

Petroleum Storage Tank Bureau

- \$2,000,000- Cleanup and site characterization at 24 state-lead facilities requiring corrective action. Associated costs – approximately \$83,000 per site.

Sub-total: \$2,000,000

Total: \$20,000,000

The estimated costs shown do not include potential long-term monitoring costs that would require additional funding in future years. All proposed work to be completed or substantially complete and all funds spent or obligated by the end of Fiscal Year 26.
