








ACCOMPLISHMENTS




- ► Continue the establishment of the Preservation Program and office, which ultimately takes control of the 2023-24 building season.
- ► Cooperation with Taos Pueblo Tribal Officials (Governor/ WarChief) and CMS Administration for State Capital Outlay funds.
- ► Annual recruitment of 11 helpers and 1 foreman.
- ▶ Develop Assessments and SOW for 2023/24 work schedules.
- ► Completion of 72 South House units.(exterior plaster and firewall replacements).
- ► Completion of 37 units on the north house. (Exterior plaster and firewall replacements).
- ▶ 3000 adobes in stock for CY 2024 building season.
- ► Harvest of 100 vigas and latillas of various sizes.
- ► Firewall Renovation/plaster on Hlauuma (North) and Hlaukwima (South) complete.
- ▶ Secured additional state funding for the 2024 construction season.
- ► Continued participation and coordination with the UNESCO World Heritage and the National Park Service



Taos Pueblo Preservation Program


The Taos Pueblo Preservation Program (TPPP) strives to protect and preserve the cultural heritage of Taos Pueblo as a traditional living community.
