

The low bid was from Rock Gap Engineering at \$11,900,000 plus NMGRT, which was above the available funding level.



Next Steps:

Building design complete. Funding for construction needs to be identified for bidding and construction.

Phase 1: Gymnasium, fitness center, administration offices, and demonstration kitchen and site development.

Description:

Constructed in 3 phases to provide wellness and health-promoting facility for Taos Pueblo. The goal is to provide healthy activities for tribal members to combat illnesses such as obesity and diabetes and to promote healthy lifestyles. The first phase wellness building will include a gymnasium, fitness center, administration offices and a demonstration kitchen.


Coming in 2024: Spider Rock Housing

Status:

- •US Department of Housing and Urban Development awarded \$7.5 million to Taos Pueblo in September for the design and construction of up to 24 new homes.
- •Schematic home designs were completed and include single-family and multifamily units.

Goal: To advertise for home construction in Winter 2024.


Resourceful at every turn of colonialism, tourism practices grew into the current state of economic sustainability, for the tribe and its people. It was a form of survival turned into opportunity.
