














- Conceptualized after five homicides occur in a single day • •

- Our mission is to provide information that is relevant to improve situational awareness.
- Work collaboratively with law enforcement personnel in patrol and investigative divisions.
- Unit is made of law enforcement personnel with experience in investigations, tactical operations and critical incidents.
- Bridge operators gather open source information (OSINT) and experts in navigating APD different data sources.
- Personnel are certified operators that go through vigorous training to obtain and maintain certifications.

The RTCC Bridge produced several investigative leads using ShotSpotter, cameras, and LPRs

- Received a call from UNMH about a shooting victim
- Victim was not cooperative but gave the general location it occurred
- RTCC found the ShotSpotter activation to identify the time and precise location of the incident

Shooting (AP230027806)



- RTCC Bridge used ART station cameras to identify a vehicle that left at a high rate of speed
- Vehicle ran a red light after the shooting
- Identified the possible vehicle as a dark colored SUV
- LPR report was generated for all vehicles in the area and supplied to officers.

The RTCC assisted homicide detectives with identifying a vehicle utilized in a homicide as well as provided de-confliction for the arrest

- The RTCC was notified of a shooting via ShotSpotter and immediately began to assist with camera footage
- Provided LPR outputs to help identify the offender vehicle and place it near the homicide

 RTCC Maintained close communications with homicide detectives and provided extensive information

DATA-DRIVEN

- Prior to homicide serving a warrant, the RTCC did a de-confliction on the address to ensure no other agencies were already working a case on the address.
- Homicide successfully arrested the homicide offender

Bus Stop Stabbing (AP230044953)



The RTCC utilized traffic cameras and ART station cameras to identify a stabbing suspect and assisted field units with locating him.

- The RTCC immediately accessed cameras in the area to locate the offender.
- While searching the area, RTCC operators observed a male running near the intersection into a neighborhood.
- Officers saturated the area, located the offender and took him into custody
- RTCC provided all video footage to the responding officers to include the initial stabbing at the bus stophe Crime Center | Technology Successes | 06.15.2023

Juvenile Absconder (AP230038140)

The RTCC Bridge assisted with identifying and locating a juvenile absconder

- Operators logged onto the call prior to officers being dispatched
- RTCC was able to identify the juvenile and advised officers he had a violent felony warrant and his history.
- The caller advised that the male got onto a bus and gave the bus number
- RTCC located the bus and tracked it until officers could stop the bus and take the male into custody near the Alvarado Transit Center







Downtown Shooting AP230040211

The RTCC Bridge proactively monitored Smart Cities Cameras and observed a shooting downtown. They provided the license plate and video footage along with LPRs that allowed officers and detectives to quickly locate and arrest the shooting offender.

Albuquerque Police Department's Sexual Assault Evidence Kit (SAEK) Backlog

- 2016 Audit revealed approximately 5400 untested sexual assault evidence kits
 - 1981 March 2017 Albuquerque Police Department's and Bernalillo County Sheriffs Office cases with a SAEK

- 2018 City Council resolution to test all kits within 90 days
 - Mayor Keller vowed that all kits would be tested.

The Results

- 4622 Kits were sent out for testing why the difference?
 - 497 kits belonged to Bernalillo County Sheriff's Office
 - Non-Reported Cases
 - Wrong Case Numbers
 - Kits Tagged Under Wrong Case Numbers
 - Duplicate Case Numbers

1830 Cases were re-opened for additional investigative steps

- Cases from year 1981 through 2017
- 1452 Profiles Entered into CODIS with at 47% hit rate
 877 CODIS Hits since 2017
