2025 – Acequia Water Savings – USDA Farm Service Agency Requested - \$15,000,000, Agreement signed, awaiting notice to proceed NM - \$13.6 million Colo - \$1.4 million

Hermit's Peak Calf Canyon Fire (HPCC)

June 2023 – Initial agreement with DFA to assess acequia impacted by HPCC December 2023 – NMACD role increased to include planning, engineering support and implementation of Emergency Watershed Program administered by NRCS Status - HPCC Acequia work completed to date:

- 116 assessment requests
- 114 assessments completed
- 8 assessments have been amended
- 4 are not eligible
- 52 diversion dams impacted/need replaced
- 66 acequias need silt and debris removal
- 17 projects completed
- 4 projects under construction
- 12 projects selected for construction 6-26-2025
- 19 projects assigned to three engineering firms focused on diversion dams
- Expended approximately \$6.3 million
