The Emergence Fund makes midwifery and doula care and other pregnancy support accessible to Indigenous families. Indigenous Women Rising's Emergence Fund is open to all Native and Indigenous people throughout the United States and Canada who are pregnant and are seeking funding to support their pregnancy or birth journey.

- Doula services
- Breastfeeding / chest feeding support
- Supplies for one's growing family
- Traditional medicine support
- Placenta encapsulation

We believe birthing is sacred, and has been for millenia. We know midwives and doulas provide both quality and spiritual care, but are out of reach for so many of our relatives. Our pregnant relatives should not have to compromise their birth journey or plan if they don't want to, and we want to help fill that gap.
