

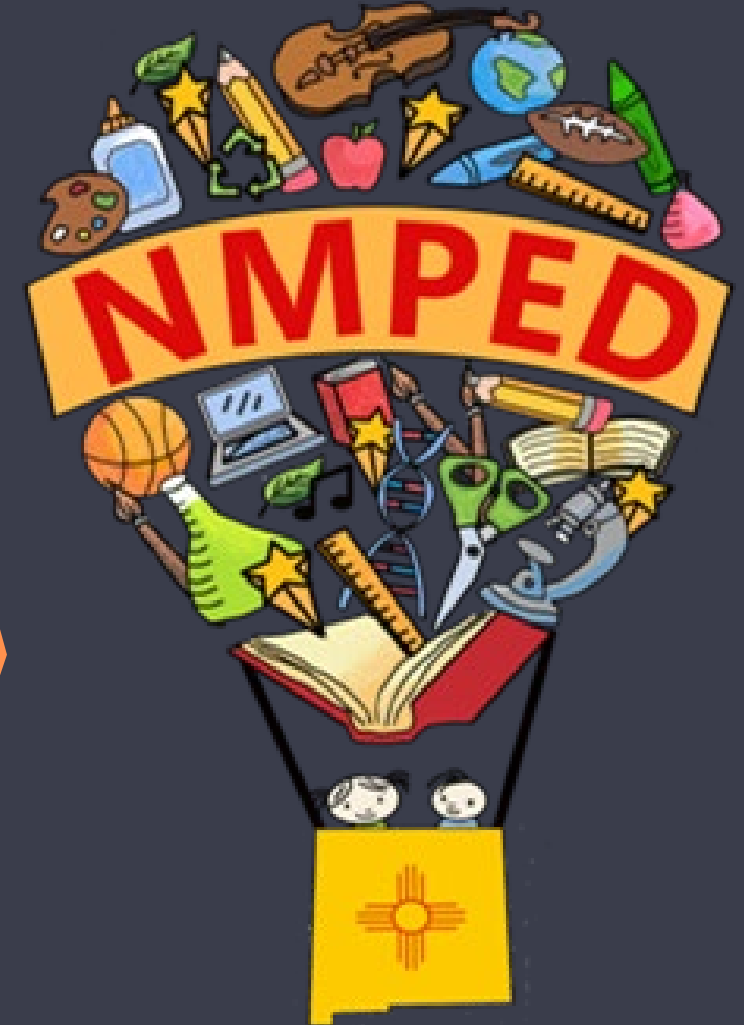

History of the PED's Learning Management System

During the COVID-19 pandemic New Mexico schools quickly pivoted to remote instruction. In response to the need to provide a platform to deliver instruction, the Public Education Department (PED) pursued an emergency procurement to acquire the Canvas Learning Management System (LMS) to amplify teaching and maximize learning for all [districts and charters](#). The procurement included licenses and support for all New Mexico public school students, educators and administrators.



History of the PED's Learning Management System

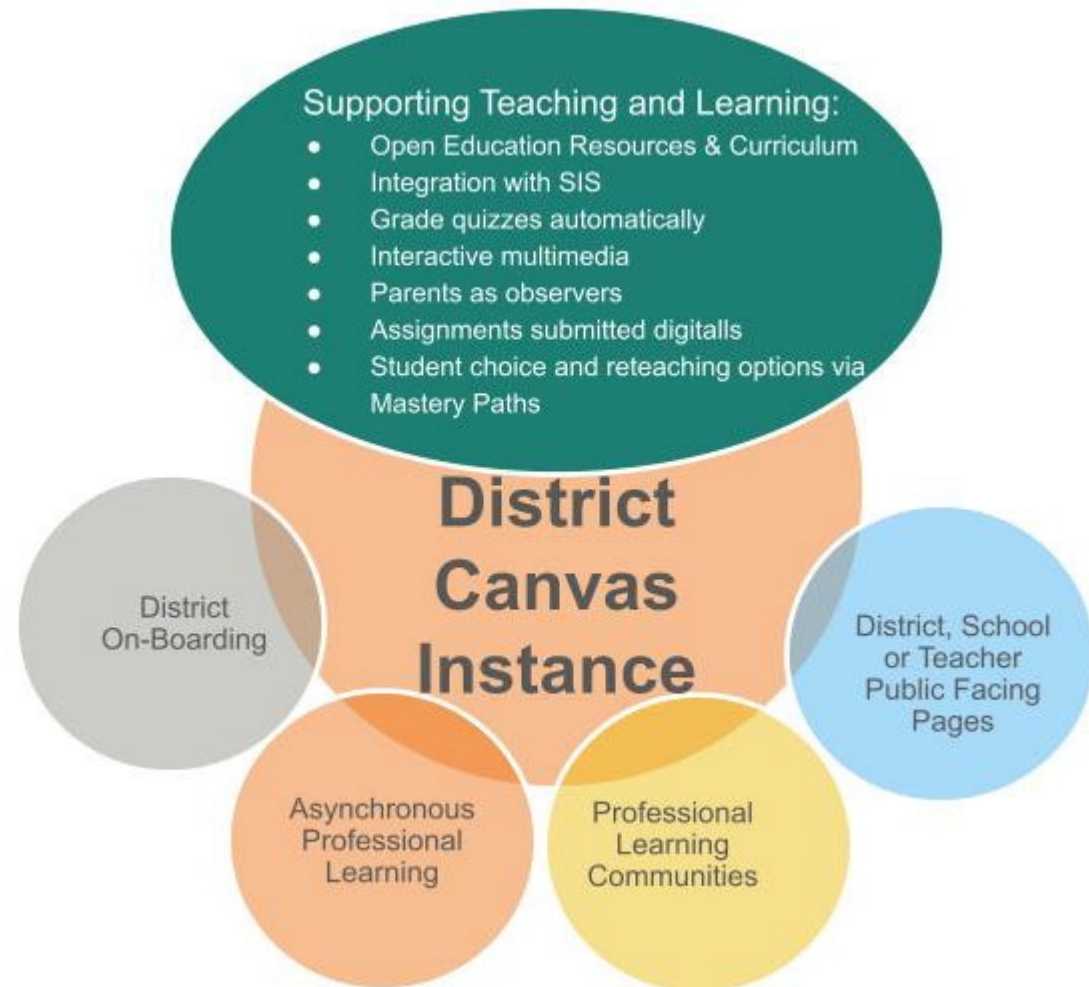


A trust consortium was created allowing Canvas accounts at the local level to also integrate with the PED. This means educators and administrators can access Canvas at their district and access PED courses with one login and password.

Under the consortium, the PED has access to the districts' Canvas platform, however districts only have access to edit courses on their Canvas platform.

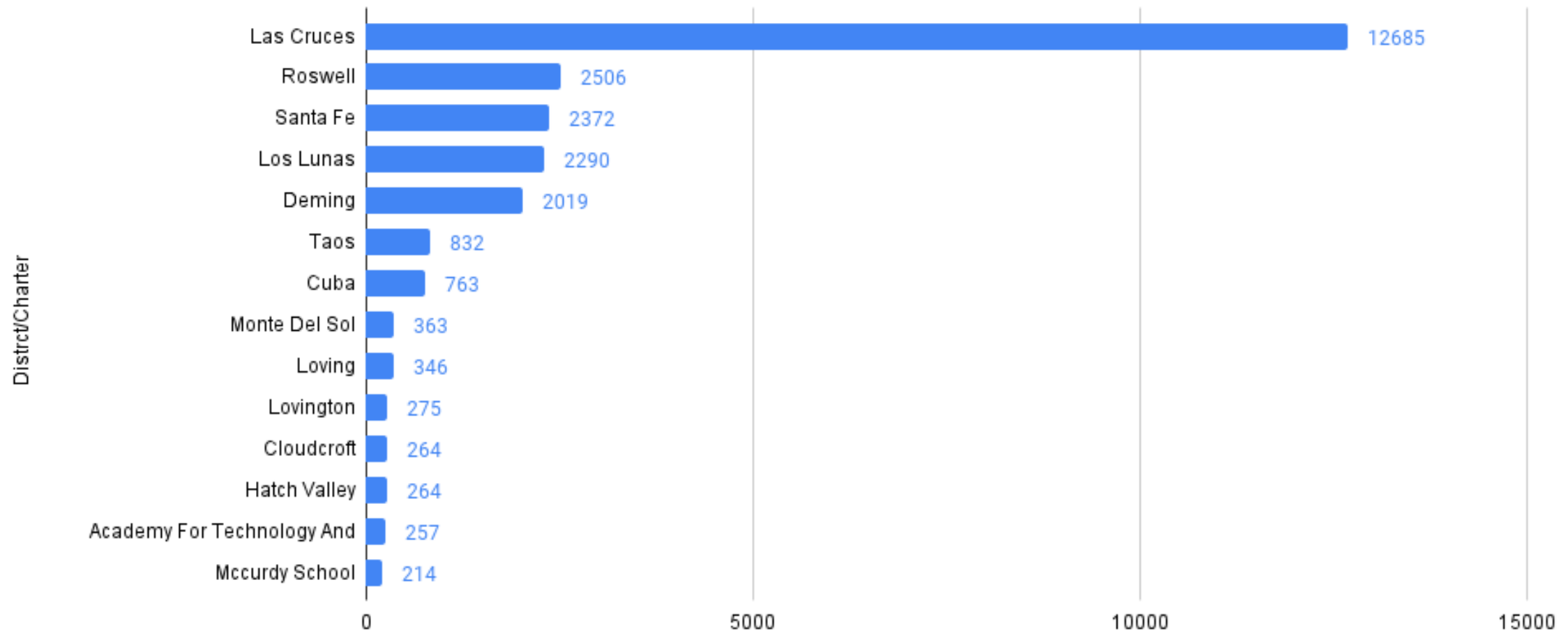
Current State of the LMS

Every district has a Canvas platform, either fully implemented and integrated to their Student Information System or a “lite” implementation which can be used for training, staff development or content collaboration.



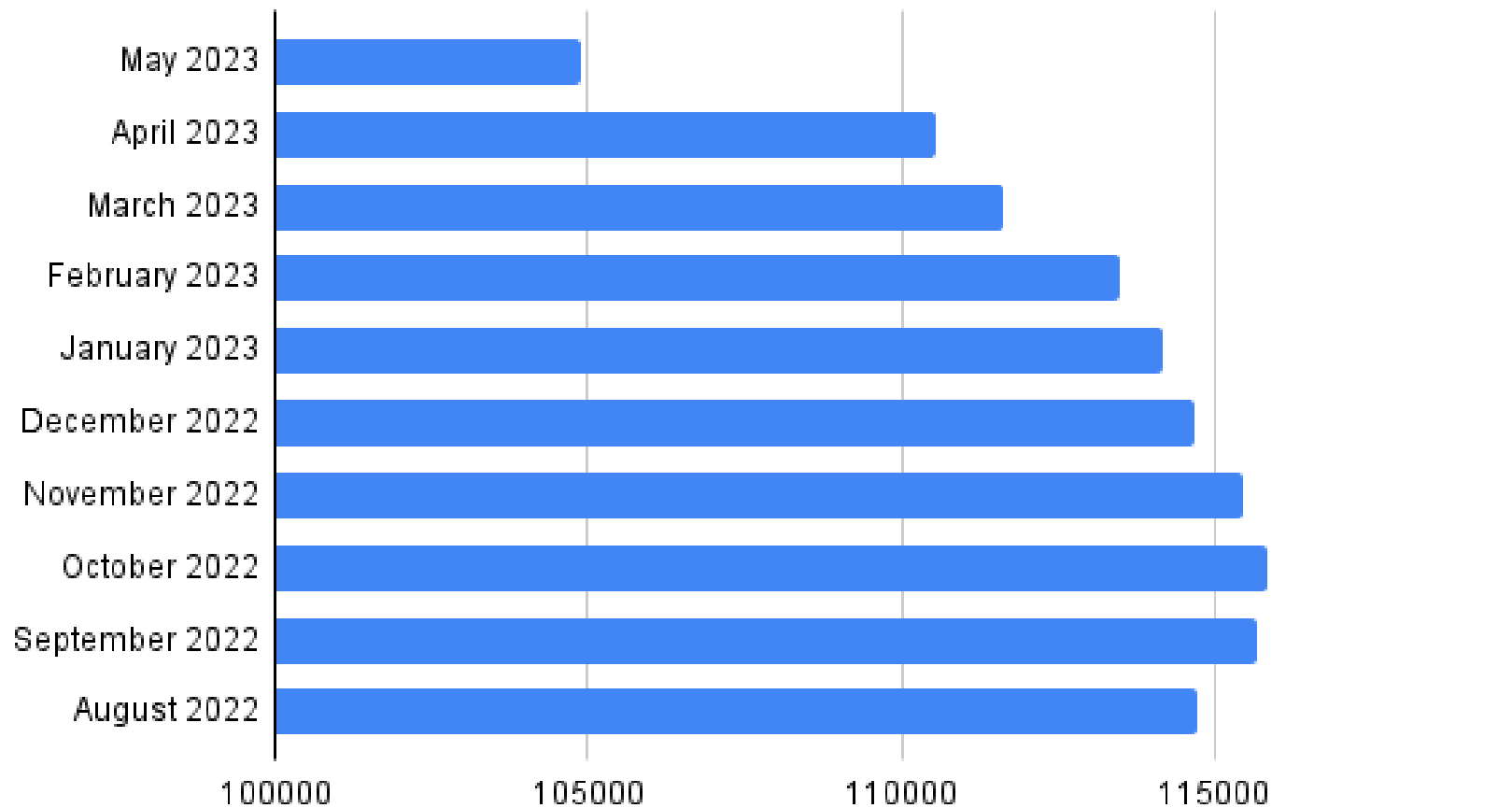
Canvas in the Classroom - # of Courses

Canvas Courses for SY22/23



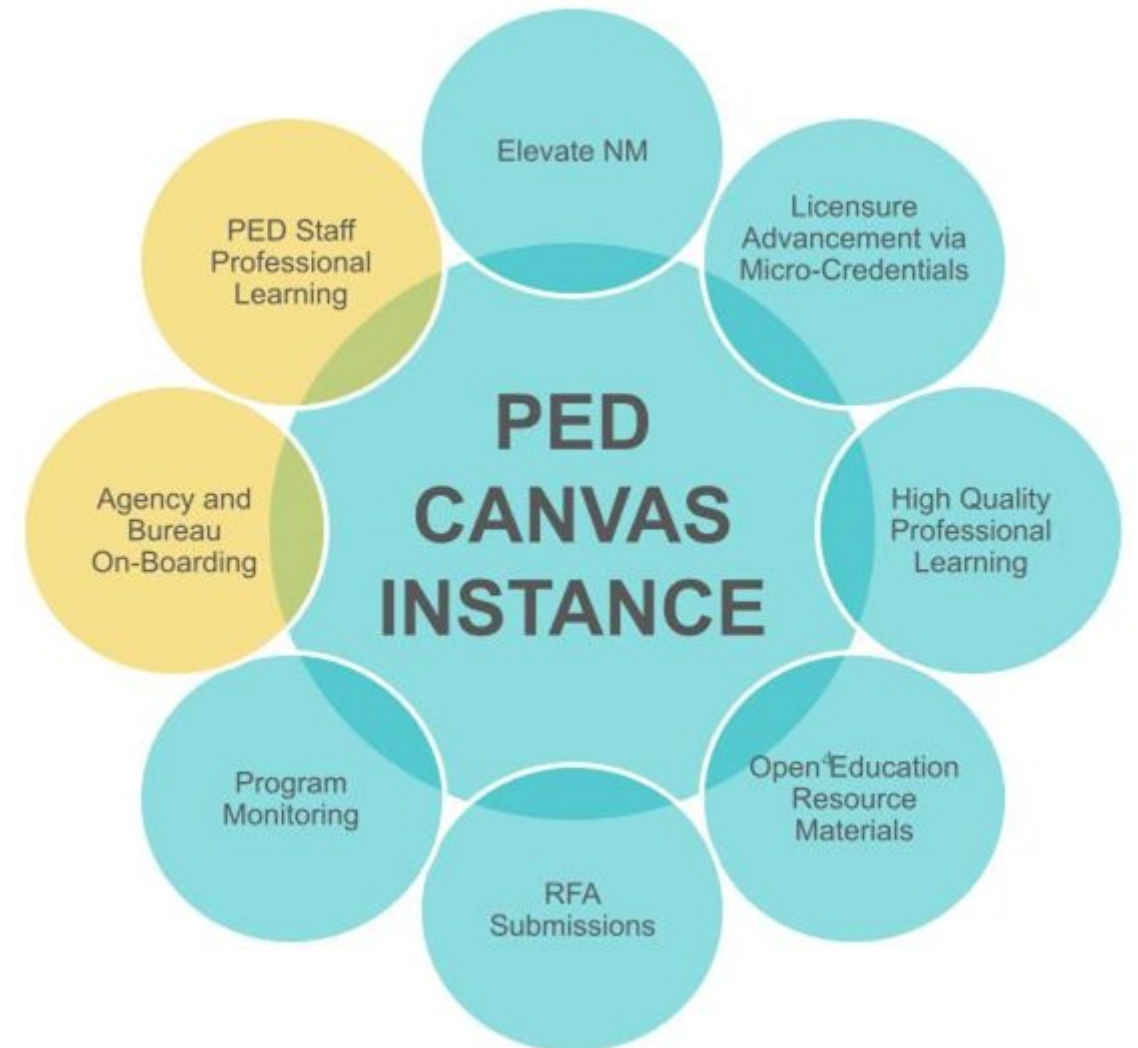
Canvas in the Classroom - Users

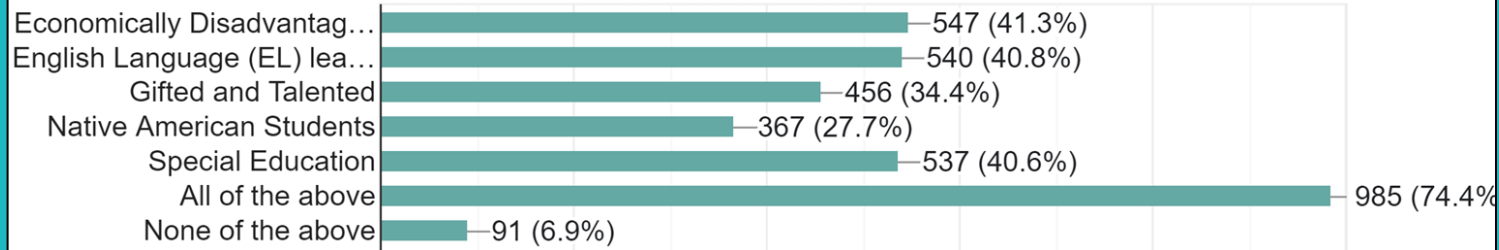

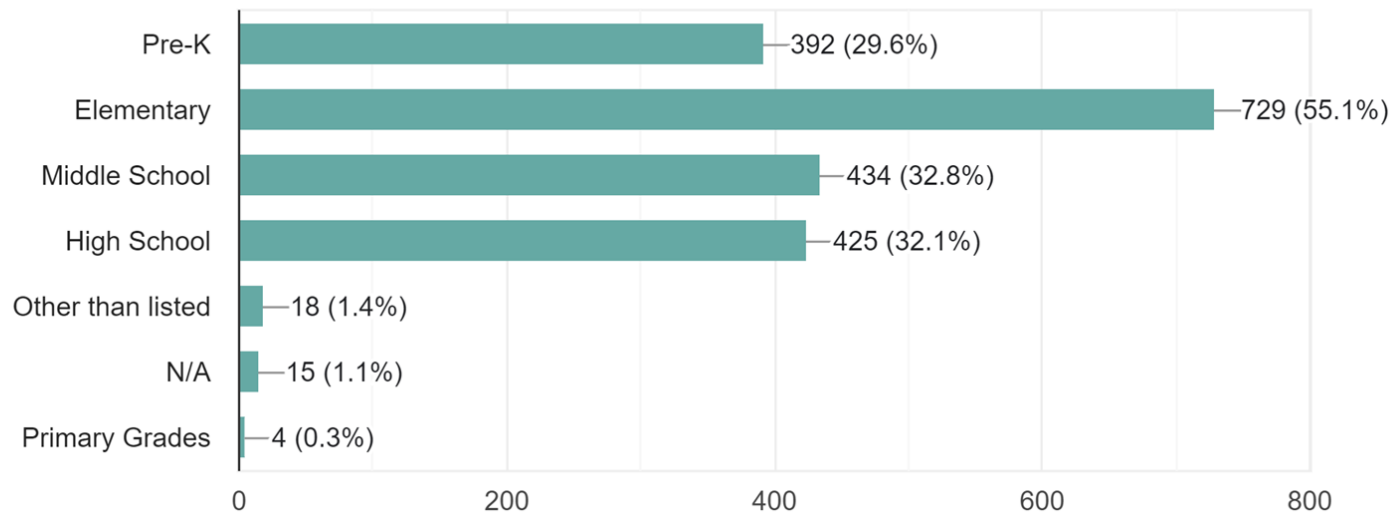
Do you teach or directly work with any of the following student populations? Please select all that apply.

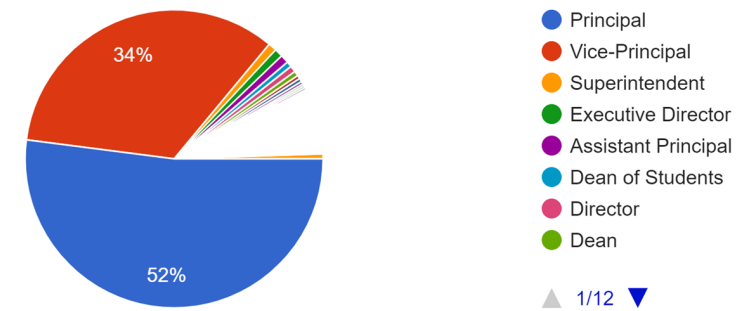
What grade levels are you currently working with? Please select all that apply

Teacher Advancement: In support of the Advancement Program Level (APL), the PED launched the micro-credential program in November, 2022 and for Level 1 to 2 advancement and July, 2023 for Level 2 to 3. Each course takes 3 months to complete.

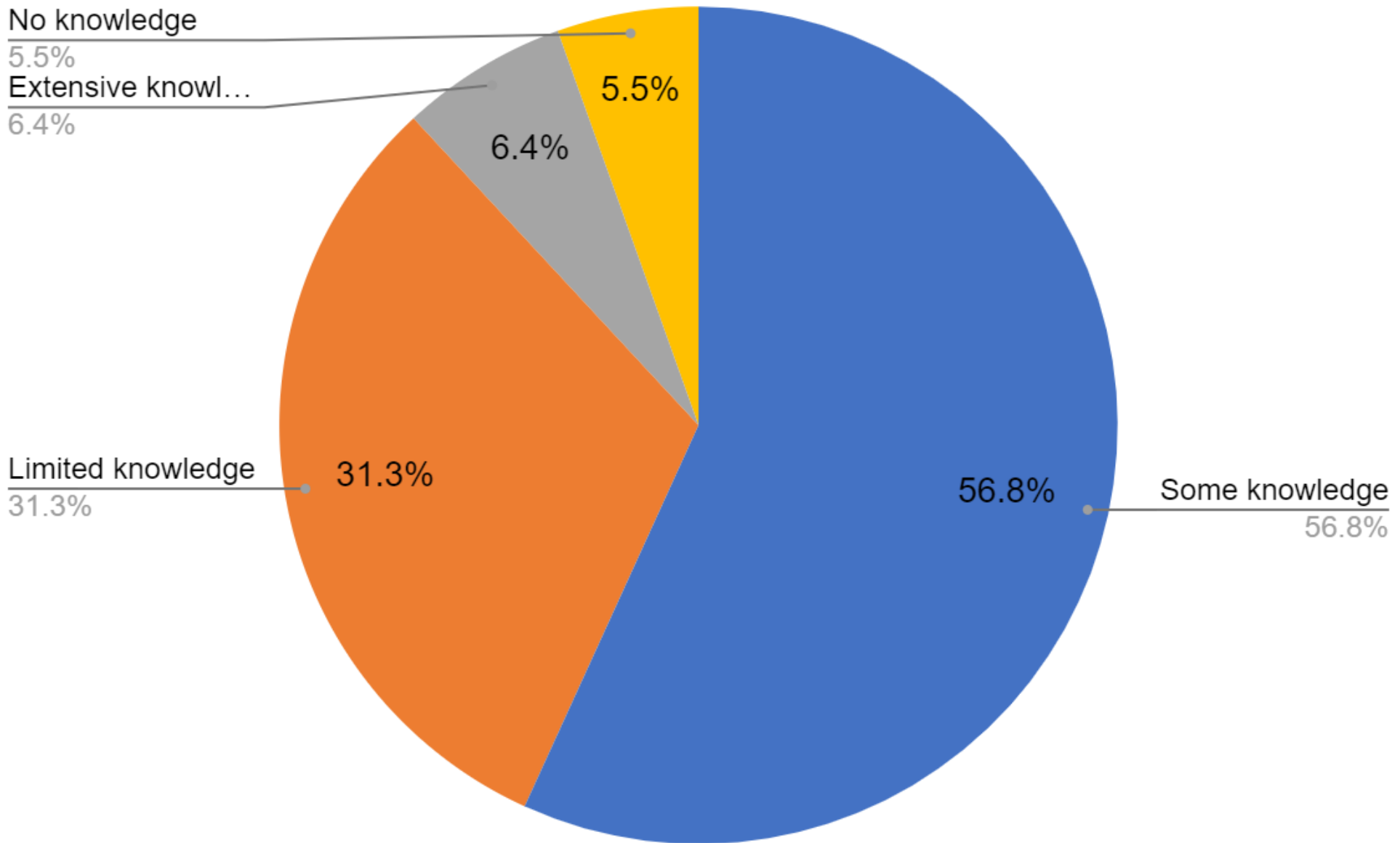
Structured Literacy and Dyslexia for Diverse Learners Course

Structured Literacy and Dyslexia for Diverse Learners Course was created as a result of the “New Mexico Dyslexia Early Interventions” law, 22-13-32 NMSA 1978. The course explains the science of reading and facilitates an understanding of best teaching practices for early reading success, information and resources on dyslexia and screening and evaluation of dyslexia.

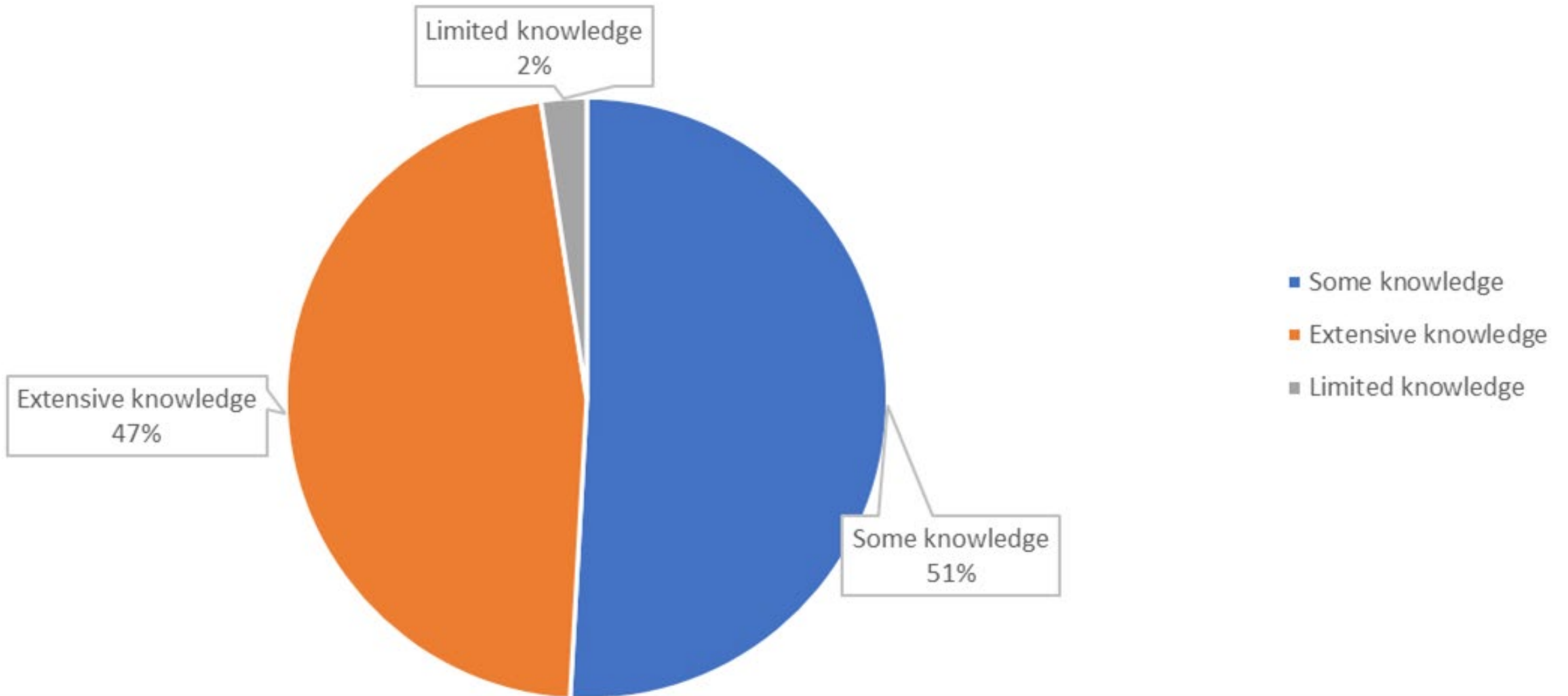

How would you rate your knowledge of Structured Literacy?

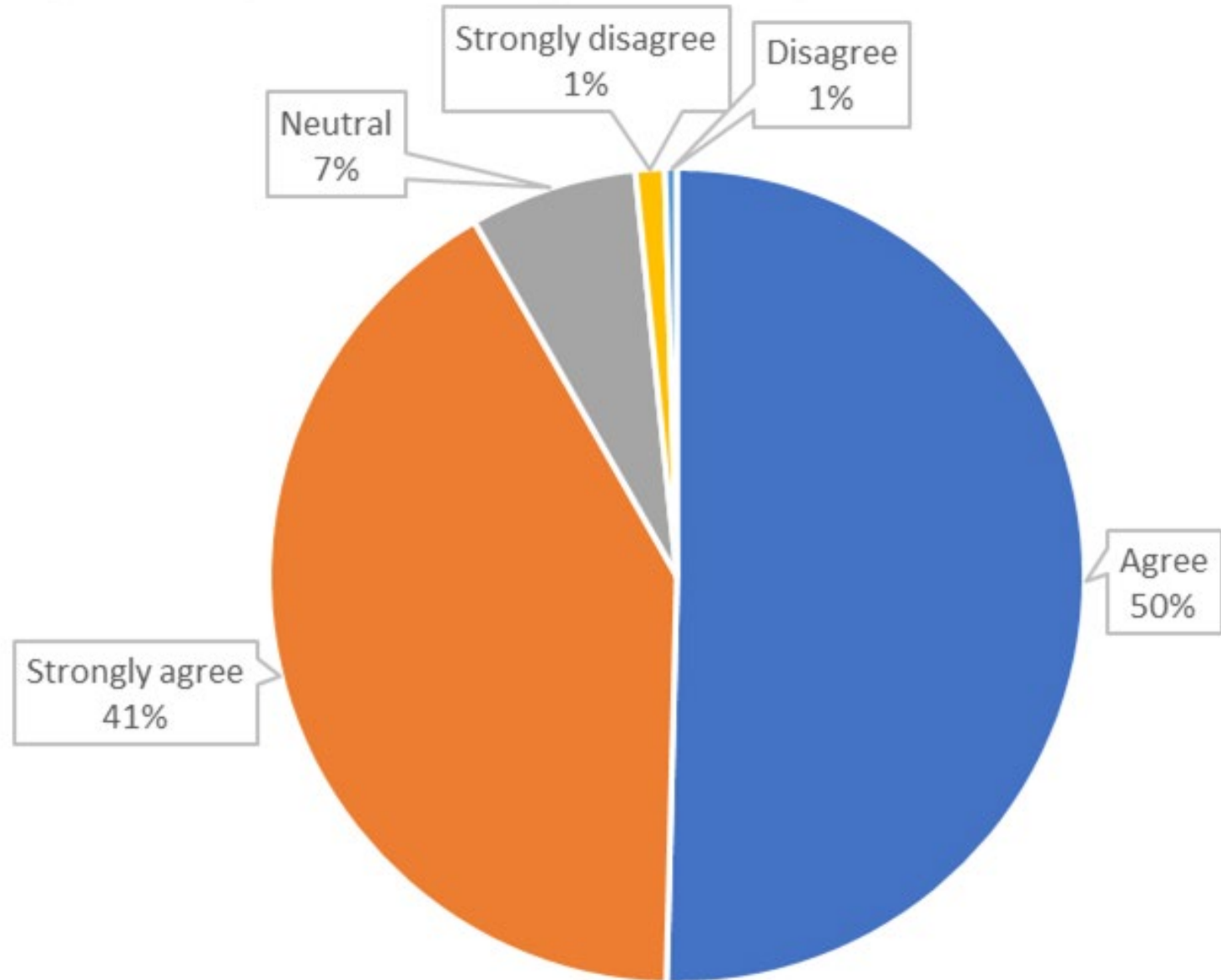


Post Course Survey

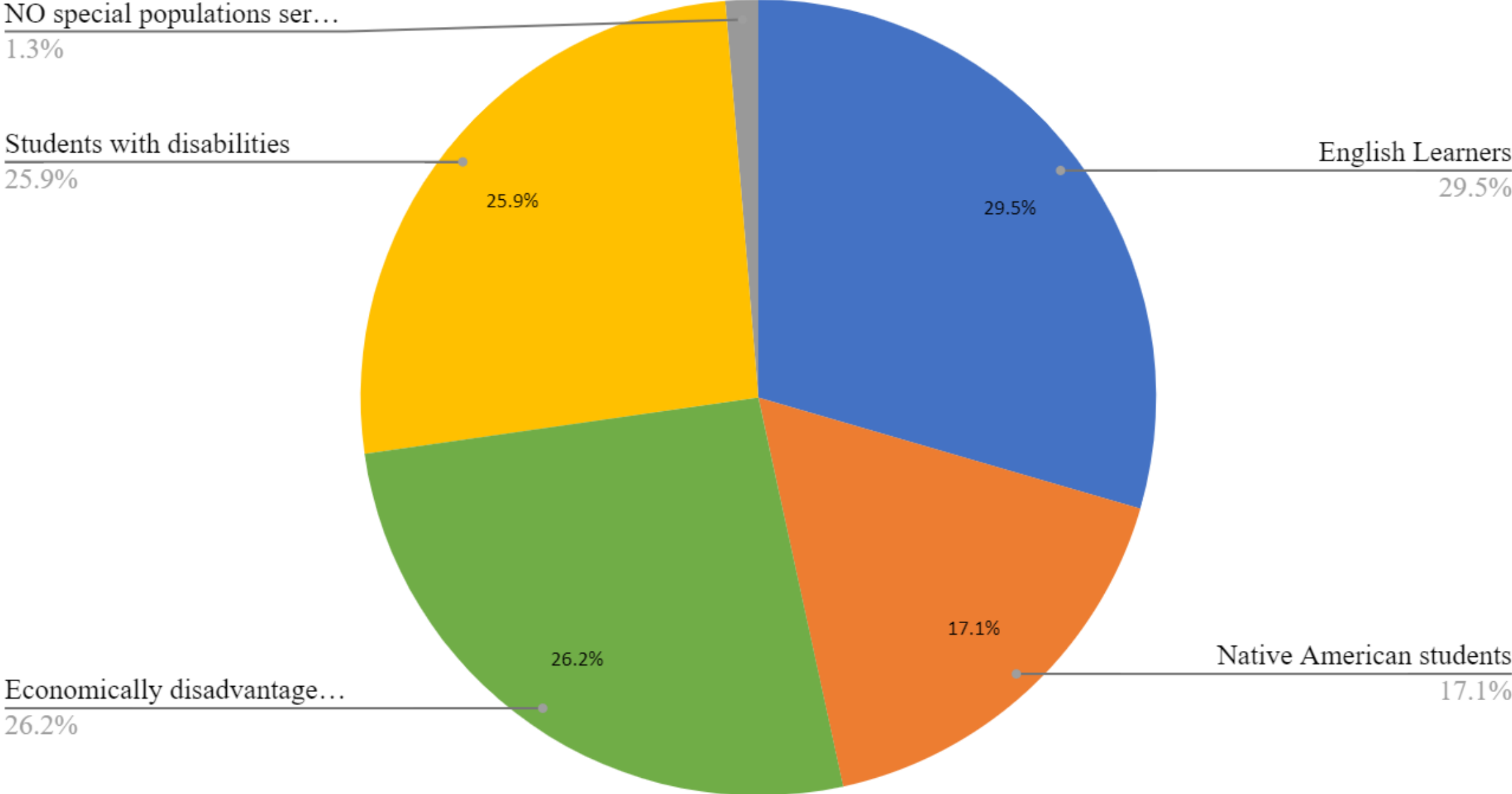
How would you rate your knowledge of structured literacy?
