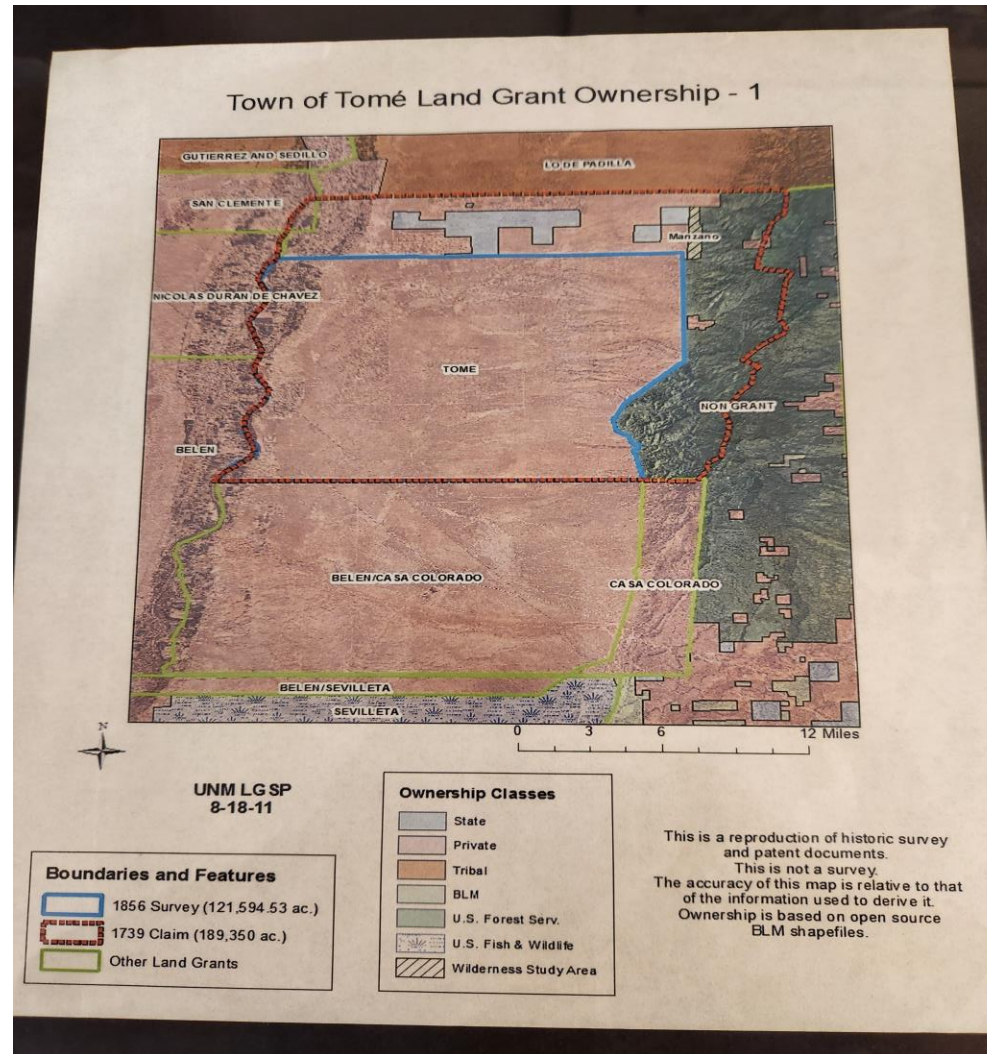


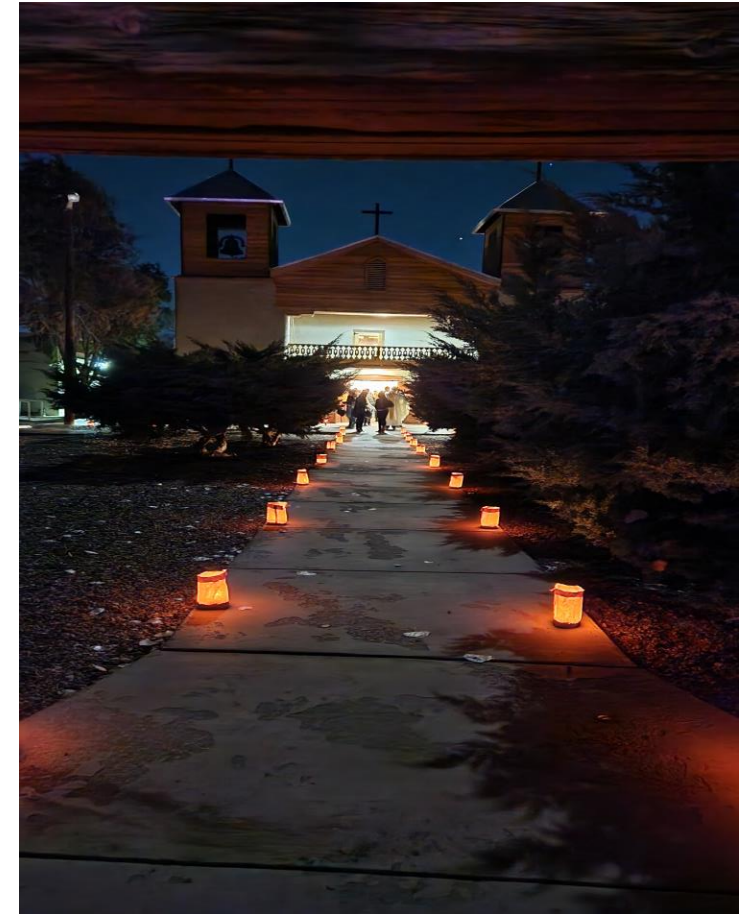

# Short History of the Town of Tome Land Grant

- 1659 Grant Awarded to Thome Dominguez de Mendoza, abandoned after the Pueblo Revolt
- Founded in 1739 by 29 genizaro families from the Albuquerque area.
- Immaculate Conception Church was built in 1746 or so and blessed in 1750.
- Original grant 189,350 acres
- 1856 Loss of 50,000 acres to Forest Service
- 1907 Loss of 92,350 acres due to taxes.
- 1968 Sold last 47,000 acres. Left us with zero land.



# Current and Recent Acquisitions

- Thome Dominguez Community Center/Museum and hall (4.73)
- El Cerro de Tome and Tome hill Park (about 180 acres)





# Current and Recent Acquisitions

- Historic Jail and Casista Site .8
- Historic Cemetary .4



Casita will be used as a rental to bring in revenue.



# Current and Recent Acquisitions

- Silva house and Property 2.7
- 1.9 acre Property
- Corner lot .8 acres
- 14.6 acres Alfalfa producing land will be leased.



Silva House will be a rental to create revenue.





# Future Acquisitions

- 3.8 acres agricultural land
- 1.4 acres of agricultural land with residential potential
- 5.3 acres of open space land
- At end of 2026 we will own 215 acres



# RECENT IMPROVEMENTS TO PROPERTY

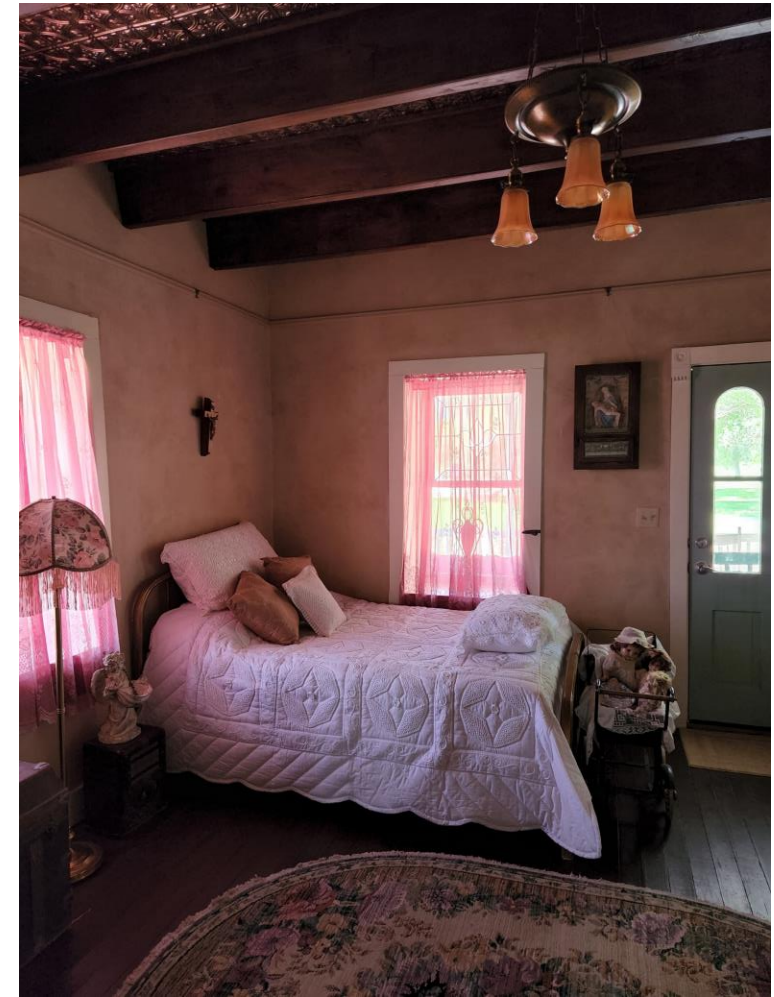
- Refrigerated Air in both buildings, water heater in Rental Hall

# CAPITAL OUTLAY

- 2021-COMPLETELY SPENT
- 2022-\$325,000- ALL SPENT
- 2023-\$550,000-ALL SPENT
- 2024-\$375,000- WILL SPEND \$100,000 AND REAUTHORIZE THE REST.
- 2025-\$50,000-WILL BE SPENT IN OCTOBER 2025.
- 2026-REQUEST \$300,00 TO \$400,000

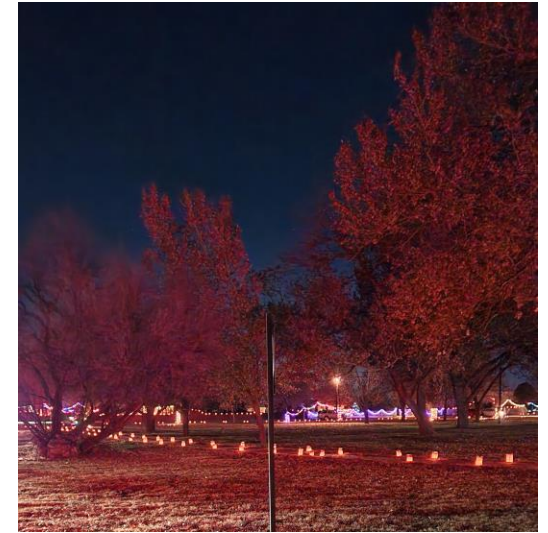


Bedroom Jail House Casita.

- Farmer's Market and Garden
- Halloween at Jail Site
- Luminaria Display at plaza, Camino Real and Jail site.
- Internships/stipends for High School and College students(come from revenues)
- Working with UNM/Valencia on archive preservation, storytelling collection and educational opportunities.
- Baseball field being used by Yucca Little League and Girls softball teams.
