Regulatory Path to Water Reuse



Augmentation not Replacement

Reuse, in any form, is meant to augment existing fresh water sources and reduce the strain on those fresh water sources.



Status of Water Reuse Regulation Development

- 9/21/2023 Advisory committee met to review draft regulations
- Second meeting to be scheduled in mid-October.
- Public outreach/ public participation
- December 2023 NMED will petition Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) for a hearing date in March of 2024.



Status of Water Reuse Regulation Development

- The draft regulation creates a new section in 20.6 NMAC titled Part 8 – Ground and Surface Water Protection – Supplemental Requirements for Water Reuse.
- This section will house reuse requirements for:
 - Direct and Indirect Potable Reuse.
 - Reclaimed Wastewater.
 - Industrial Graywater.
 - Produced Water (Outside OCD jurisdiction)
 - Desalination.
