

## Public health threats include:

- Illnesses, including asthma and respiratory disease, from smoke and poor air quality
- Rise in diseases like Valley Fever, West Nile, Zika, dengue, etc.
- Physical and mental health impacts from fires, floods, and heat waves
- Prisons, schools, athletic fields, pet shelters, are all getting hotter
- People who work outside suffer and sometimes die
- Certain common medications make people more vulnerable to heat-related illnesses.
- Unbearable pressure on unhoused populations
- Strain on hospitals, clinics, and emergency workers (including wildland firefighters)
- Heat waves make us madder, sadder, unhappier



## Economic impacts include:

- Crop losses (across scale & including tribal economies)
- Real estate and small business losses
- Increased costs of homeowners insurance (or loss of coverage)
- Infrastructure losses
- Medical costs, public health costs, lost work and wages
- Losses to tourism
- Disasters and disaster response
