





#### Our 25th annual report




- Puts air pollution into everyday language
- Gives the public local information
- Focuses attention on particle pollution and ozone
- Gives grades to 885 of the 911 counties with monitors (out of 3,221 counties)
- Ranks 25 metro areas with worst pollution (& cleanest) for 3 pollutants.

### **Particle pollution** is a mixture of tiny solid and liquid particles, sometimes called "soot."






## Ozone pollution is an odorless, colorless gas that forms most on hot, sunny days, sometimes called "smog."

People of color were 2.3 times as likely as white people to live in a county with 3 failing grades.




#### Our Changing Climate is a Health Emergency

- Spread of infectious diseases








"State of the Air" Report Year


