Commencing at a point on the Rio Hondo where the Eastern boundary line of the lands of Juan Antonio Valdez intersect

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at a point on the Rio Hondo at a place where the west boundary line of the lands of Juan N. Gallegos intersect the same, running thence northerly along said boundary line two miles to a point number three; thence easterly from point number three to point number two aforesaid; the sourthern boundary line being the northern boundary line of the Antoine Leroux Grant.

- 3. That the plaintiffs have a good and indefeasible estate in fee simple in and to all and singular the premises hereinadove described.
- 4. That the defendants have no right, title or interest in and to the land and real estate hereinabove described, or any part thereof.
- , 5. That the lands hereinabove described are within the out boundary lines of the lands described in plaintiffs' complaint. It is, therefore,

ordered, Adjudged And Decreed by the Court that the estate of plaintiffs in and to all of the lands and real contact hereinabove described, and every part thereof, be and it is hereby established against the adverse claims of the defendants Julian A. Martinez, Joseph E. Lacome and Thomas P. Minutes of a meeting held today August 5, 1914

This meeting was held with the purpose of letting the people know about the agreement of the grant, that Don Antonio B. Trujillo made with the Srs. J. A. Martinez, Gable and Lacome and the people were well satisfied. The boundaries given are on the East the boundary of Don Anto A. Valdez two miles to the north from there to the west the boundary of Juan Angel Vigil or Juan N. Gallegos.

Don Cosme Pacheco made a motion and the motion was accepted that all those that are delinquent have to pay five dollars from now to the 15 of September and the rest to the 15th of October to finish and close the costs. The sum at hand collected the sum of \$138.70 and \$40 dollars more to the 15th of September that are on the list.

Description of the boundaries of the Stipulation and agreement held by Sr. A.B. Trujillo with Thomas Gable, Joe Lacome and Julian A. Martinez

Starting on a mojonera or mound fired where the Canada del Agua meets with the Rio Hondo from there all along the Rio Hondo to the west with three miles and a half more or less to a mojonera or mound afixed where the Canada de los Cayguas meets with the Rio Hondo and from that mojonera or mound a direct line to the North by a distance of two miles where another mound is fixed from there a line to the East for a distance of three miles and a half more or less to another mojonera or mound fixed from there a direct line to the South for a distance of two miles which is the starting point of the mojonera where the Canada del Agua meets the Rio Hondo.

These minutes are with the object of having amended the minutes of the meeting that took place on August 5th 1914 which as of now have been approved by this meeting held today December 18, 1915 as testified.
