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New Mexico State Veterans' Home is currently home to 128 residents with room to house up to 131 residents.





Who We Are

- The New Mexico State Veterans' Home is a long-term care and skilled nursing facility
- NMSVH offers 24-hour nursing care while safely assisting residents to live as independently as possible

- NMSVH Vision Statement:

"Working together to provide the highest quality of care and the best quality of life for veterans and their families."

Facility Overview

- Annex Building
 - 59 beds in 5 units
 - Includes secure units to support memory care needs
 - Private rooms with private bathrooms
 - Contains beauty shop, physical therapy gym, and movie theater
- Newly built homes
 - 6 new houses 12 residents per house
 - Designed to create a homelike environment and promote independence
 - Private rooms with private bathrooms
 - Rooms available for couples who wish to live together



Eligibility

- Honorably discharged veterans with 90 days or more of service and their spouses are eligible for admission
- Preference is given to New Mexico residents when there is a waiting list – but every veteran is welcome to apply. We are not restricted to New Mexico veterans only
- Gold Star Parents, who have lost children in the service of their country, are also eligible
- Certain members of a reserve component of the US Armed Forces who meet the legal residence requirements



Population Served

- NMSVH offers a diverse population of residents. We are home to men and women with approx. 13% women and 87% men
- NMSVH serves from WW2, Korean War, and the Vietnam War
- Our residents' range in age from early 60's to over 100 years old
- NMSVH's residents have a variety of care needs to include medication management and assistance with Activities of Daily Living, to full assistance and support



Population Served

- World War 2 – 1 resident
- Korean War – 11 residents
- Vietnam War – 78 residents
 - Gulf War – 6 residents
- Peace Time – 18 residents
 - Spouses – 14 residents



Population by Payor Source

- Service Connected – 42
 - Private Pay – 7
 - Medicaid – 68
- Medicaid Pending – 8
 - Hospice - 3

Financials

- VA covers the cost for Veterans with a service-connected disability of 70% or higher
- Medicaid, Medicare, and Private Pay are accepted forms of payment
- Monthly payments are determined from an individual's income and assets. Our financial office reviews the required admission documents to determine financial responsibility prior to admission

Veterans Home Projects

- NMSVH passed the VA recognition survey in March 2025 which officially recognizes the 6 new homes
- NMSVH has become a model to build similar facilities throughout the US
- Increased staffing at NMSVH NMDOH to provide more services for veterans and their families
- NMSVH receives community support from many organizations to include Department of Veteran Services Veteran Service Officer once a week as well as the Vet Center bi-weekly that offers counseling services for the community.
