

Student Information Systems


A Student Information System is:

- A computer database.
- Widely used by staff, teachers, students, and parents.
- Critical to school operations.
- A tool to deliver reporting data.

Percent of NM Student Information System (SIS) market share by student enrollment




New Mexico Statewide Student Information System

Benefits of implementing the Statewide Student Information System (SSIS) include:

- Unified technical support.
- Faster and easier student transfers.
- Fewer chances of losing students during school transfers.
- Improved data accuracy.
- Near real time data.
- Additional features and modules available to smaller schools.
- Families have just one SIS to learn and use.
- Burden reduction from automation and integration of the SIS.
- Reduced costs for both schools and the state.

Statewide Student Information System Implementation

Cohort One

70 school districts and charter schools have signed up. (deadline of 9/30/2025 for interest and 11/15 for contract)

2025/2026 Conversion Year

Schools use legacy SIS while adding data to Synergy (conversion fees waived for cohorts 1 and 2).

2026/2027 SIS and Special Education

Schools will use Synergy for the SIS and for special education.

2027/2028 Teaching and Learning Modules

Schools may add additional elements such as the learning management system, multi-layered systems of support, and assessments.
