School Grade Points by Criteria



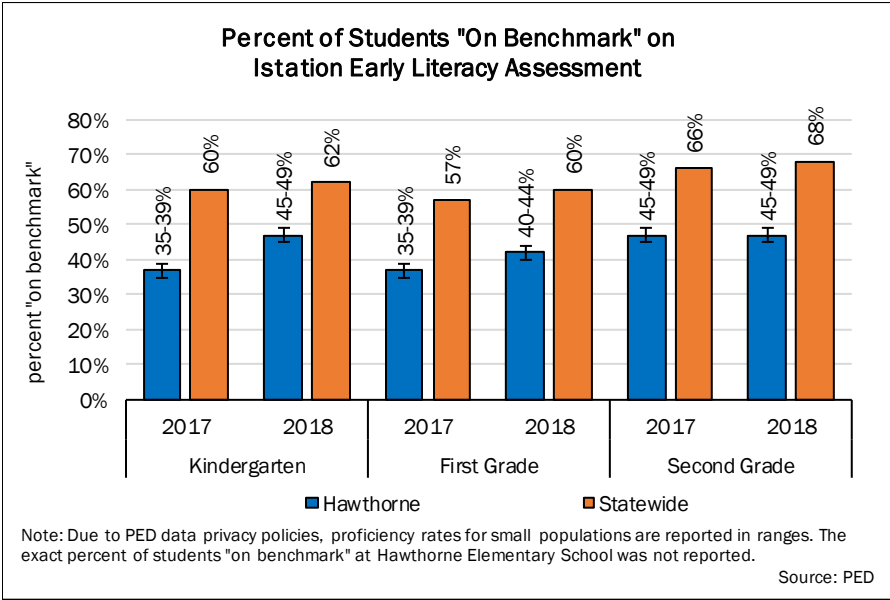

School Grade Points by Criteria



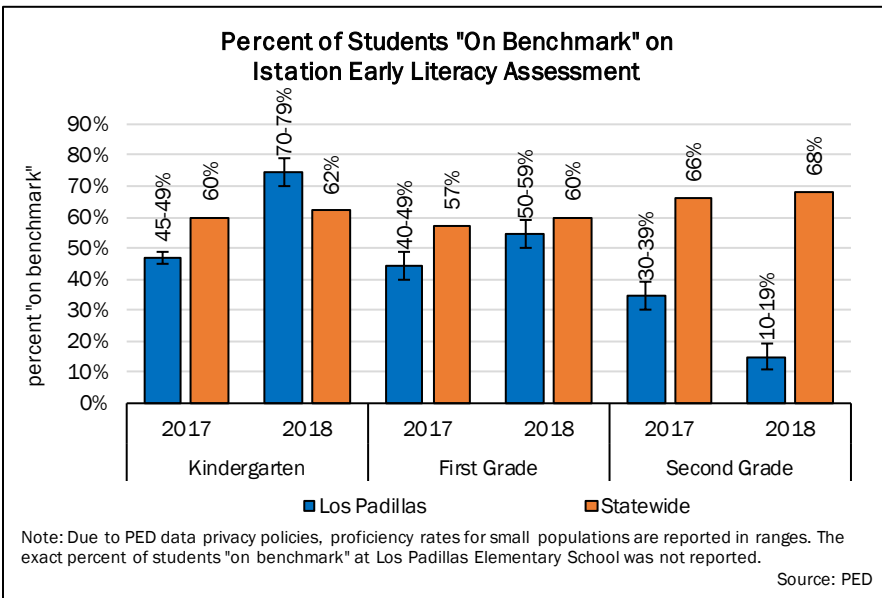

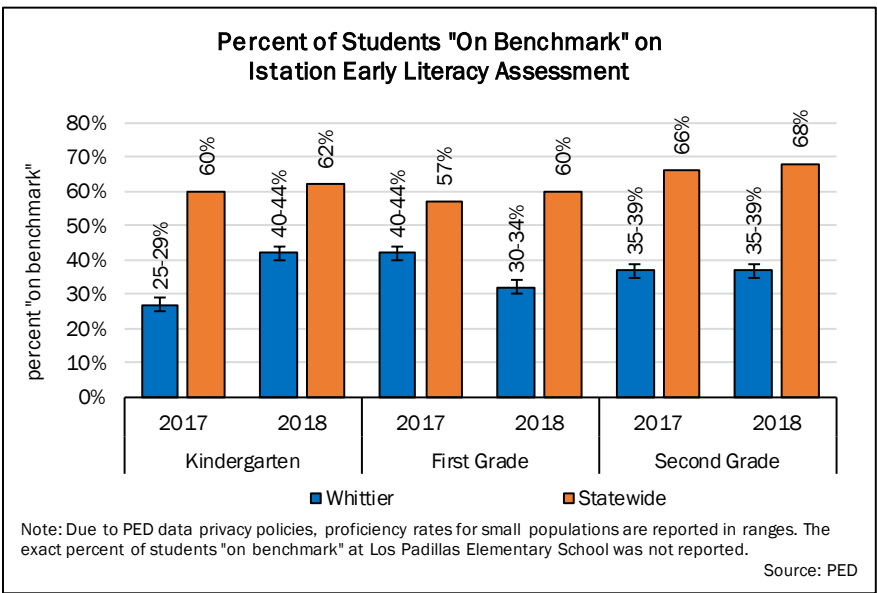
