

# **Top FY25 Accomplishments**

- \$2.589 billion in earnings
- Three wind leases, record solar lease and ten community solar projects (projected to earn over \$615 million; enough power for up to 73,500 homes)
- Rio Sol & NextEra transmission lines (\$100 million)
- Executive Orders protecting the Caja del Rio landscape & Pecos watershed
- WSMR conservation agreement on 60,000 acres (Cupadera Mesa); protected 20,000 acres of LPC habitat
- Additional 36,000 acres surveyed for cultural resources


- Clean financial audit while processing over 25,000 payments



### **Budget Request Overview**


### Total Request: \$32,104,800

- Budget paid from agency earnings (Not General Funds)
- \$1,817,300 increase over FY26 (6%)

#### **Increases By Category**

- S&B
  - **\$1,501,500 (6.3%)**
  - 5% vacancy rate, three new FTE
- Contractual Services
  - **\$87,500 (+2.9%)**
- Other
  - \$228,300 (+6.9%)

### **Personnel Requests**

#### Senior Forester

 Thinning projects, prescribed fires and healthy forest initiatives; partnerships with sister agencies, non-profit organizations and agricultural lessees

#### Economic Development Projects Manager

- Manages local government partnerships on major economic development initiatives, planning and development leases, land exchanges and key state priorities (e.g., housing)
- Example: Development of 4,300 housing units in Las Cruces, 40% of which will be affordable


#### Commingling Petroleum Engineer

 Commingling results in less surface disturbance through consolidated locations and equipment; translates into reduced emissions, less damage to land and lower costs for industry
