Upstream

Exploration & Production

Finds natural gas and crude oil reserves and brings them out of the ground.

Midstream

Transportation & Storage

Connects the upstream producers to downstream refiners by moving and storing materials.

Downstream

Refining & Distribution

Turns crude oil and raw gas into finished, usable products for consumers and businesses.

Why Good Roads Matter



Heavy Equipment Transport

Heavy trucks carry drilling rigs, pipes, and large machinery to remote work sites. Weak roads can break under this heavy weight.



Lower Transportation Costs

Smooth roads cause less wear and tear on vehicles. This reduces repair costs and saves fuel.



Faster Response Times

Good roads help repair crews and supplies reach active wells quickly. This prevents costly delays in production.



Worker Safety

Paved or well-maintained dirt roads lower the risk of vehicle accidents. Workers travel safely to and from remote fields.



Environmental Protection

Paved or gravel roads stop mud and erosion. They prevent oil or chemical spills caused by stuck or tipping trucks.
