All Statewide Assessments, Third Grade through 11th Grade

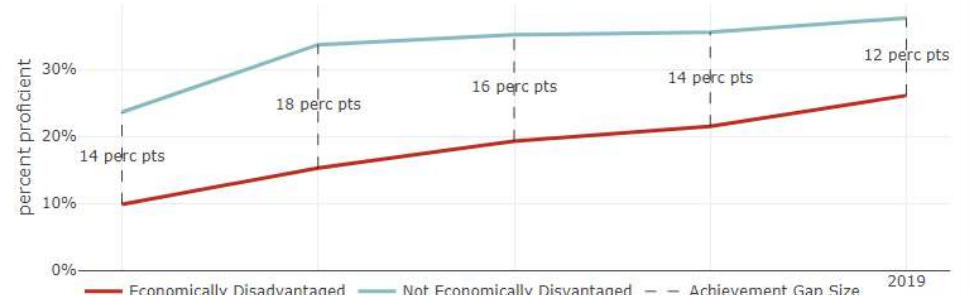

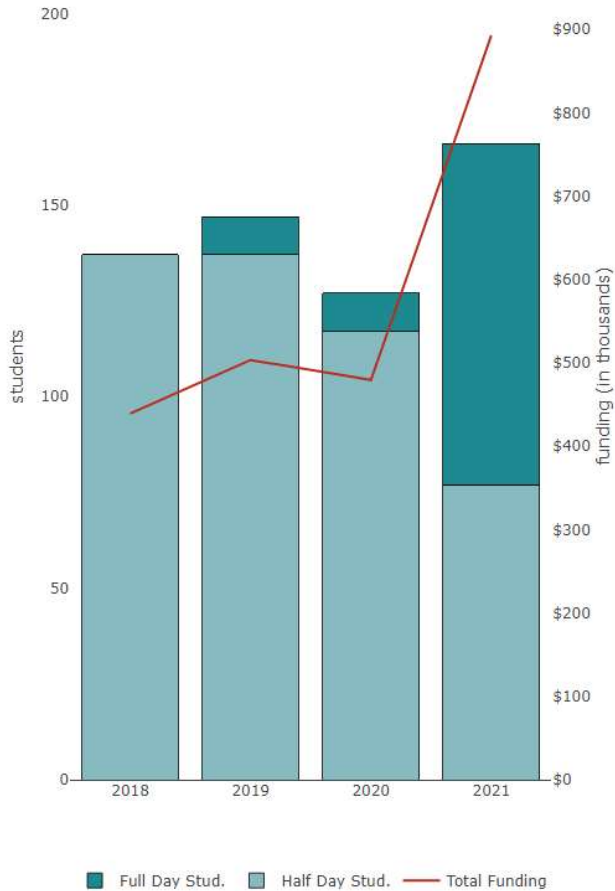

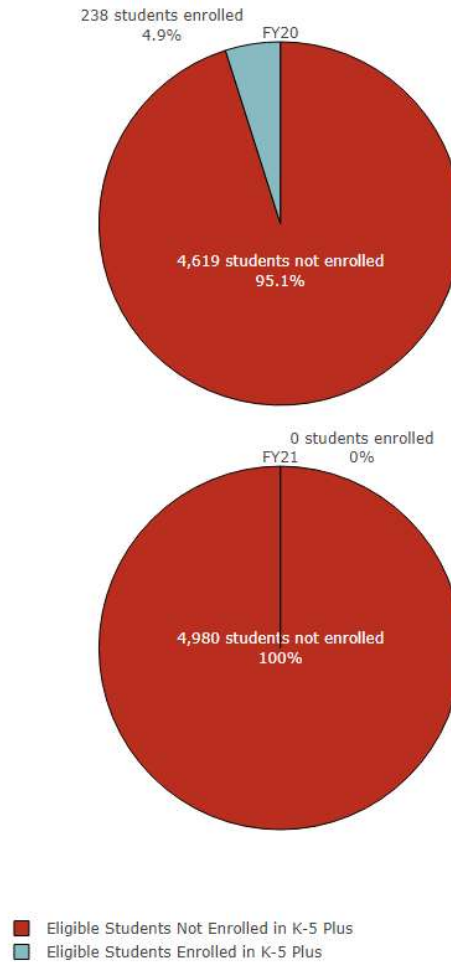

Prekindergarten Programs



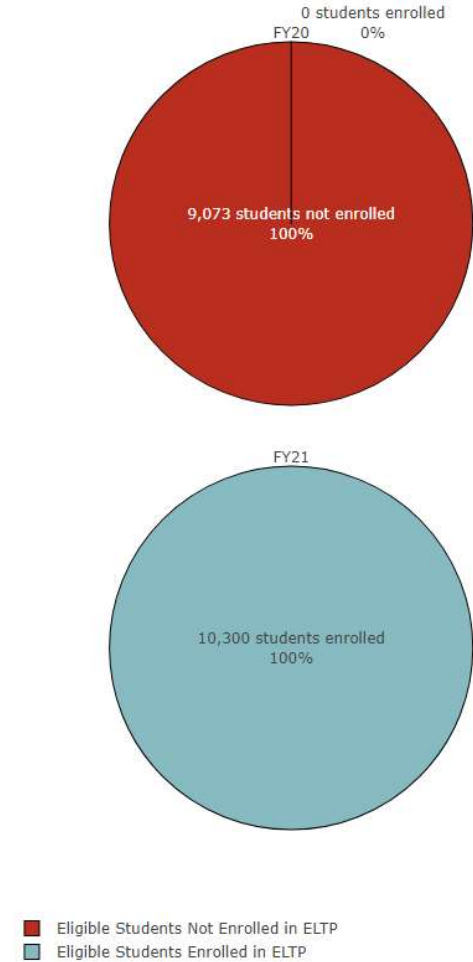
