PROJECT PLANNING

- Always check ICIP
- Capital Outlay is not guaranteed
- City uses state capital to leverage our decade plan projects
- Non-profits create challenges



ADMINISTRATIVE CAPACITY

- City has three grant administrators for Capital Outlay
 - Municipal Development for DFA
 and DOT
 - Senior Affairs for ALTS
- We have multiple staff working on capital outlay yet still have challenges





TECHNICAL CAPACITY

- Albuquerque has strong technical capacity
- We have the technical staff to be able to spend grant funding in a responsible, timely manner





FUNDING FOR NON-PROFIT ORGS

- We are creating a process to support non-profit organizations
- Projects are usually not on the ICIP
- Some projects still get through
- Some projects still violate antidonation

RIGHT SIZING STATE SUPPORT


DFA | DOT | CABQ working together
