- The History of Project Management is the history of mega projects of the last 4,500 years that include the Giza Pyramid, the Parthenon, the Colosseum, the Gothic Cathedrals of Europe, the Taj Mahal, and the Transcontinental Railway.
- \*\*These were not anomalies in history but projects delivered in a systematic way with very similar characteristics to today's projects.

# **PROJECT MANAGEMENT**

 PROJECT MANAGEMENT is the application of knowledge, skills, tools, and techniques to project activities to meet the project requirements.

# PROJECT MANAGEMENT PROCESS

- \*\*Projects managed with a project management process, have a higher probability of success.
- Project management processes fall into five groups:
- 1. Initiating
- 2. Planning
- 3. Executing
- 4. Monitoring and Controlling
- 5. Closing

- TEST GROUP Identify/Select a group of state agencies/municipalities/counties to participate
- **GOAL:** Develop, Train and Retain a Dedicated Project Management Staff at State & Local level
- OBJECTIVE: Capital Outlay Staff become Project Management Certified
- HOW: Attend the NM Edge New Mexico Certified Public Manager Program
- **INCENTIVE:** Costs covered by a Capital Outlay Administrative Costs Set-a-aside
- REWARD: Public Entities with "Certified" Project Management Staff will receive 0.5% to 1% Administrative Funds to administer and execute Capital Outlay Projects
