





- New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations [20.4.2 NMAC]

## KAFB Permit (EPA ID# NMD9570024423; NM ID# 2400)






# Pump and Treat Interim Measure Update

\*Plume maps are based on actual field measurements and not computer simulations





#### **PFAS**

- Persistent in groundwater and documented adverse health effects

#### **Background**

- NMED implements regulatory authority:
  - Ground Water Quality Act violation for discharging without permit
  - Resource Conservation and Recovery Act requires corrective action
- 2018 U.S. Department of Defense (DOD) discloses contamination at Cannon & Holloman Air Force Bases
- 2019 NMED and the State Attorney General sued the DOD seeking action on the imminent and substantial endangerment to public health and the environment caused by PFAS pollution
