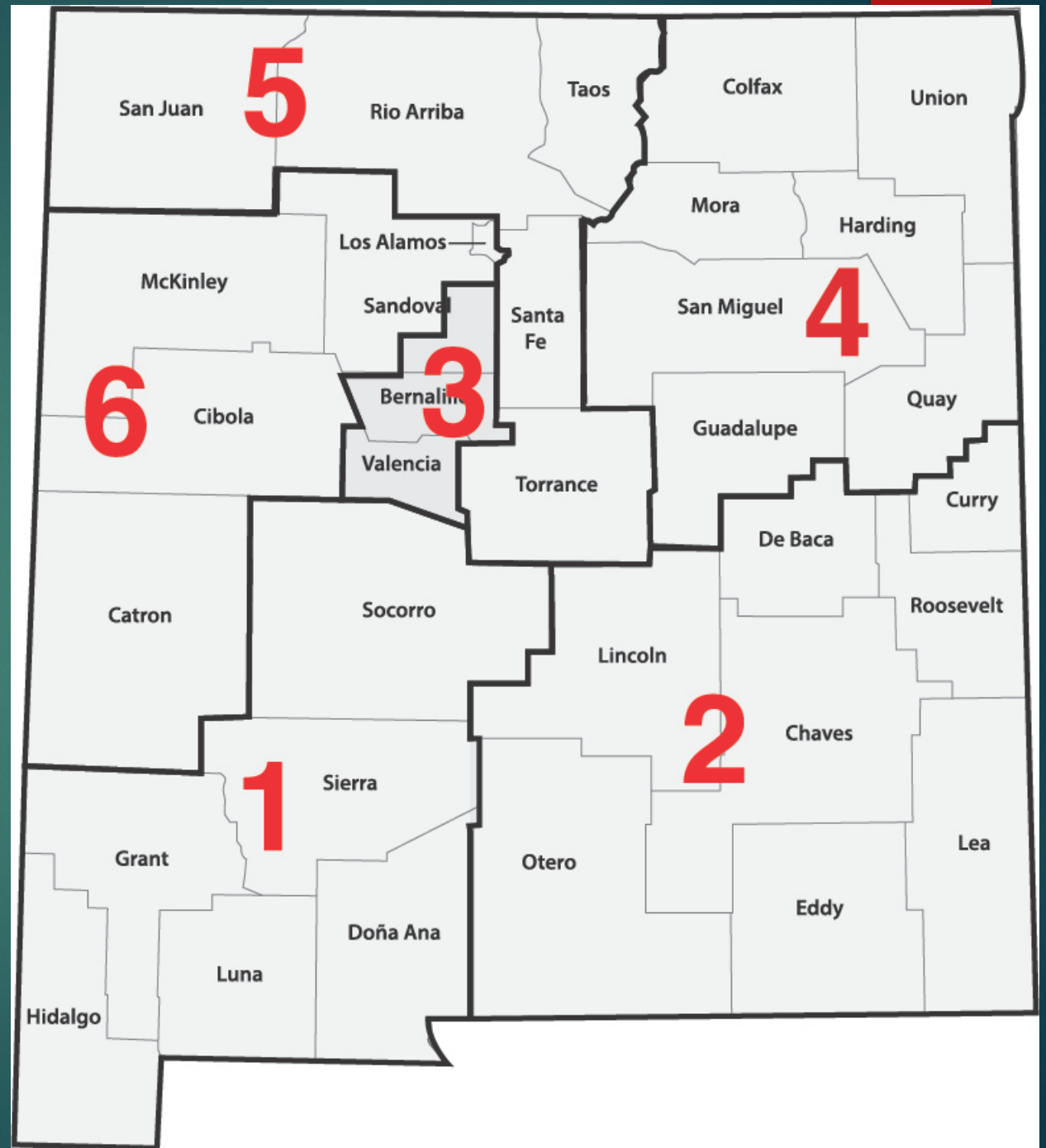

- ▶ Environment

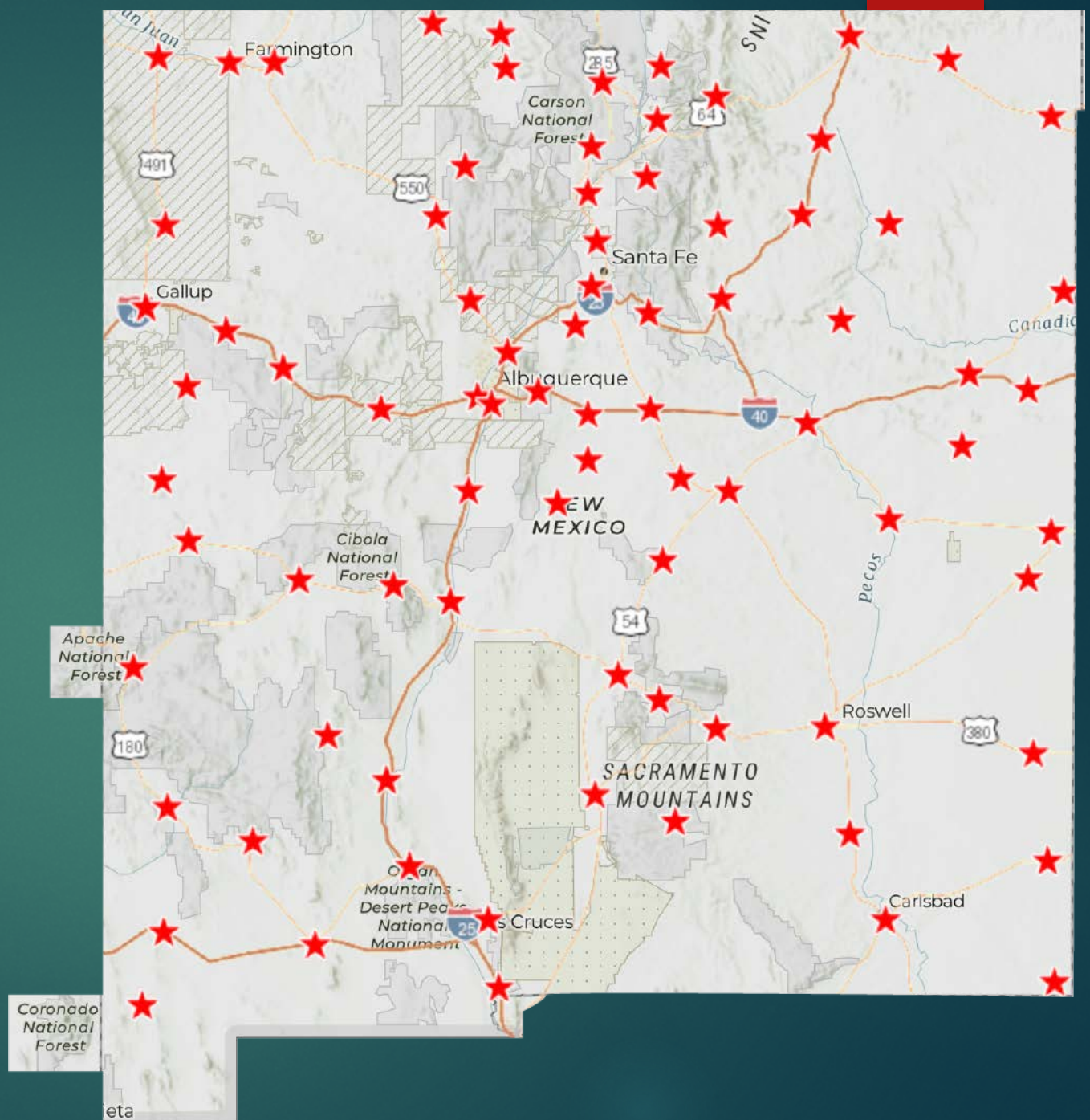
NMDOT District Map

NMDOT Patrols

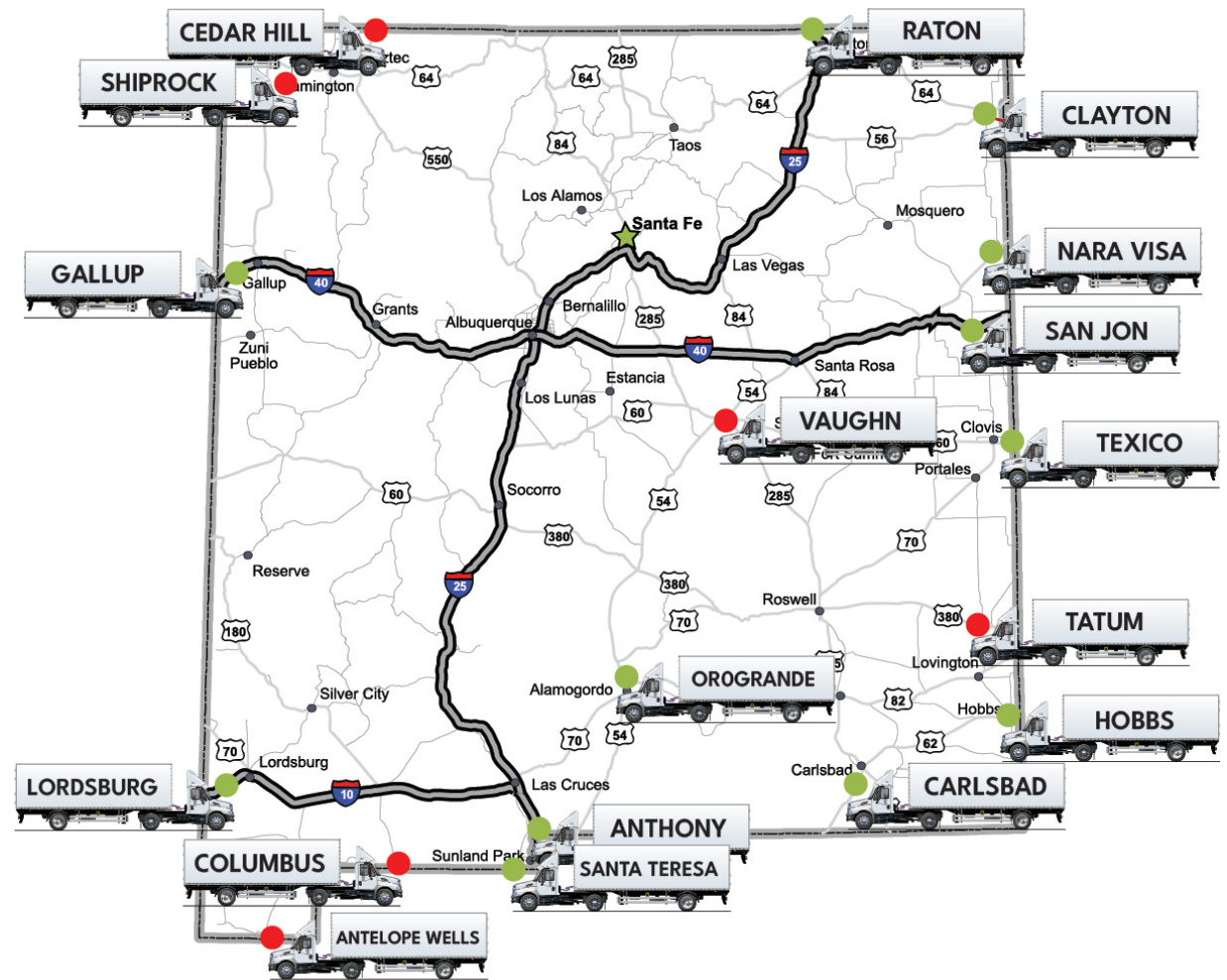
The department currently has 82 patrols in operation across the state.



Ports of entry

NMDOT, and DPS began discussions in March 2014, to improve the ports of entry. Four months later NMDOT secured a \$1.5 million Federal Highway (FHWA) contract to research possible solutions. The goal was to alleviate the administrative role of DPS.

This allowed them to focus on what they do best, which is to monitor and inspect incoming commercial trucks that enter the state.

● LOCATION OF ACTIVE PORT OF ENTRY ● LOCATION OF INACTIVE PORT OF ENTRY

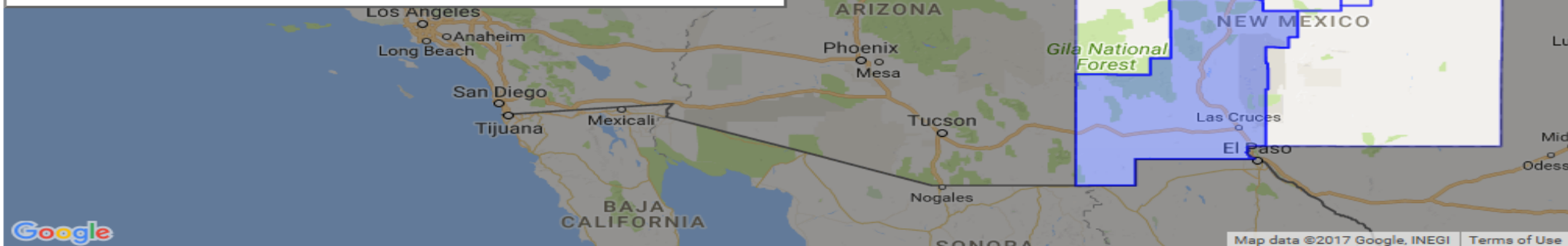

- ▶ \$1 Billion operating budget this year (includes State/Federal). Gas/Special Fuels Tax, Weight Distance, Vehicle Registrations, & Motor Vehicle Excise Tax
- ▶ 2600 FTE's
- ▶ Current Vacancy Rate about 15%
- ▶ Received \$985M Special Appropriations/Bonding Authority since 2019
- ▶ Received \$1.2M for EV Charging Station Network

- ▶ Recurring Revenue

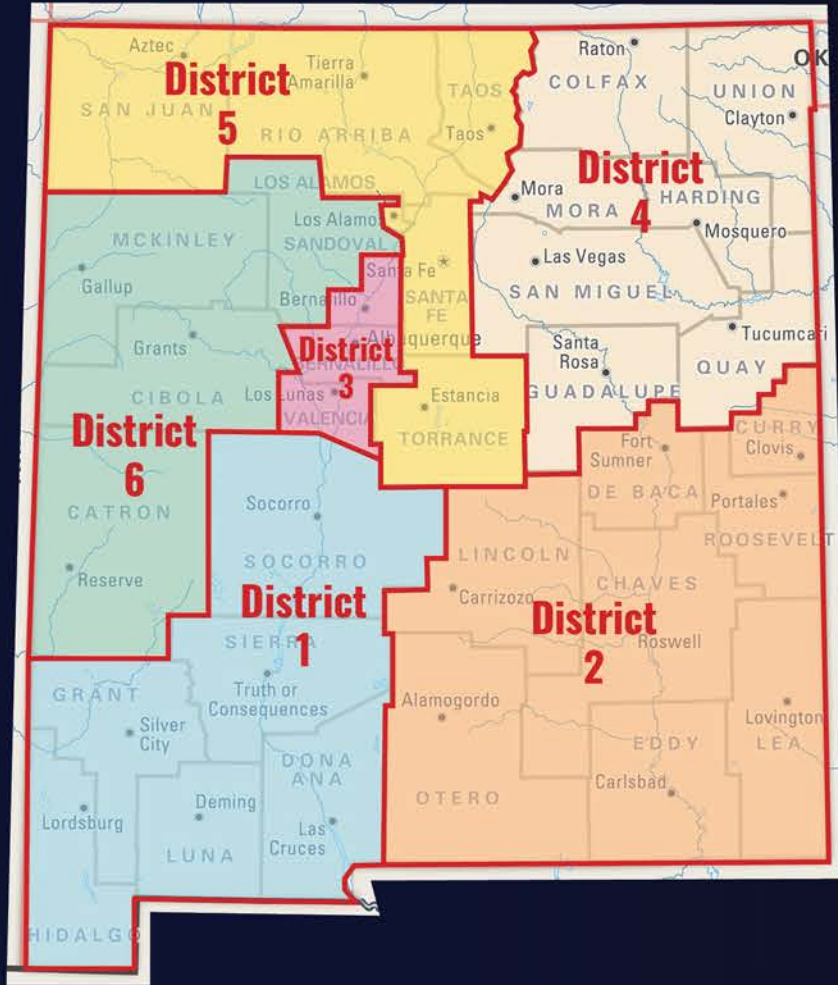

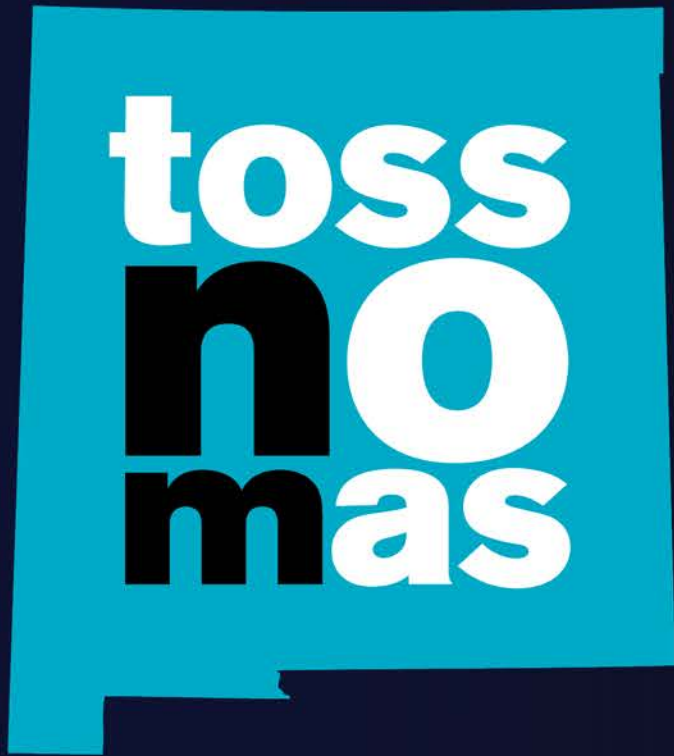
- ▶ Short Debt Portfolio
