- 58 law enforcement agencies
- FY 2019:
  - 6,100 enforcement hours
  - 5,652 seatbelt citations
  - 306 child restraint citations

- 84 law enforcement agencies
- 21,206 officer hours
- FY 2019:
  - 24,034 speeding and 2,694 seatbelt or child restraint citations
