Statistical/Demographic Information


- Total Population = 11336 (City = 64.3%, County = 35.7%), 6th largest district in NM
- Ethnic breakdown = Nat. American = 82.6% , Hispanic = 14.2%, Other = 3.2%
- SPED = 13.4%
- ELL = 27.6%
- Free and reduced = 57.6%
- Homeless = 584 (5.2%)
- Budget total in 2016-17 = ~ \$205,000,000
- Taxable land = ~ 22%
- Number of employees = ~ 1900 , Largest employer west of ABQ corridor, south of Grand Junction CO, north of the Mexico border, and east of Phoenix/Las Vegas NV
- Number of schools = 34, 2nd largest number of schools in a district in NM
 - 18 Elementary
 - 7 Middle Schools
 - 9 High Schools
- Sparsity information = ~4957 square miles, would compose of 7 districts in comparison
 - Distance = 15 of 34 schools are 25 to 103 miles away from Central Office
 - Total # Bus routes = 115 per day (to and from), 2.5 million miles per year
