# Acequia work in process and completed

- Requested \$15,000,000, Agreement signed, awaiting notice to proceed
- NM \$13.6 million
- Colo \$1.4 million
- Hermit's Peak Calf Canyon Fire (HPCC)
- June 2023 Initial agreement with DFA to assess acequia impacted by HPCC
- December 2023 NMACD role increased to include planning, engineering support and implementation of Emergency Watershed Programadministered by NRCS
- <u>Status HPCC Acequia work completed to date:</u>
- • 116 assessment requests
- • 114 assessments completed
- • 8 assessments have been amended
- • 4 are not eligible
- • 52 diversion dams impacted/need replaced
- $\cdot$  66 acequias need silt and debris removal
- <u>· 17 projects completed</u>
- • 4 projects under construction
- • 12 projects selected for construction 6-26-2025
- • 19 projects assigned to three engineering firms focused on diversion dams
- • Expended approximately \$6.3 million
