

CHALLENGES UNDER NMSC RULE LR3-303

Stricter

LR3-303 is much stricter and more specific than the general NMRA rules. It imposes hard deadlines, track-based trial schedules, mandatory early hearings, and strict sanctions for failure to comply.

"Pilot Program"

LR3-303 is identified as a pilot project.

There should be a more in-depth review of its impacts.

There is no evaluation period built in to review effectiveness.



Arraignments

An individual must be arraigned within 15 days, if out of custody - or 7 days if in custody.

Witness List

Once the initial list is filed, there is little flexibility to amend the witness list past the deadline.

Status Conference

Eliminate initial status conference. Track determination could be made via email. Save time and cases.

ARRAIGNMENT CHALENGES

- Arraignment scheduling, caps, and tight deadlines lead to administrative conflicts.
- 60-80+ notices have to be sent out to both defendants and defense attorneys.

Pre-Trial Interviews

One missed PTI can lead to dismissal of the case. No allowance for second interview

Discovery

More flexibility in discovery deadlines.

15 Days after arraignment.

The District Attorney does not have direct control over law enforcement agencys that provide nearly all of the evidence.

OTHER ISSUES

- Hazard Pay for Prosecutors
- Retention & Recruitment Funds
- Expanding Attorney Pool for Prosecutors
- Underutilization of Treatment Courts
- Financial Sanctions of Attorneys
- Pay Equity Between District Attorneys & District Judges
