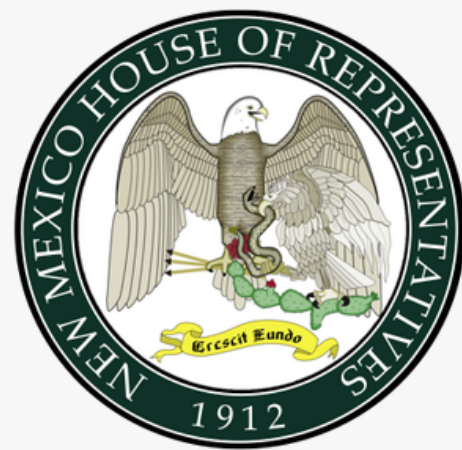

NM'S SURVIVOR'S TRUTH COMMISSION

Jeffrey Epstein operated an international crime operation for decades. One of his primary United States properties — Zorro Ranch in New Mexico — was a hub of that operation.

1993

- First documented NM connection. Victims were trafficked to and from New Mexico. Institutional failures led to crimes that were never investigated or prosecuted in NM

2008

- Florida conviction and Federal non-prosecution agreement shielded enablers

2019

- Federal arrest and death of Jeffrey Epstein

2022

- NM settles with Epstein's banks

Present Time

- Survivors have never had a formal, public record of what happened
- Looking to NM laws and institutions that must change in order to bring justice to survivors and to prevent these crimes in the future

GOVERNING PRINCIPLES

Survivor Centered

Victims will have an unfettered, formally recorded opportunity to tell their full stories in a manner of their choosing- if they choose to do so. This Commission's work belongs, first, to them.



Justice & Rule of Law

“Crimes of this magnitude are offenses against the community and against the rule of law — not merely against individual victims. The body politic itself requires repair.”

Truth Before Reconciliation

Premature calls for forgiveness, without full accounting of facts, compound the harm done to survivors. We will not rush to resolution at the expense of truth.

Primary Jurisdiction

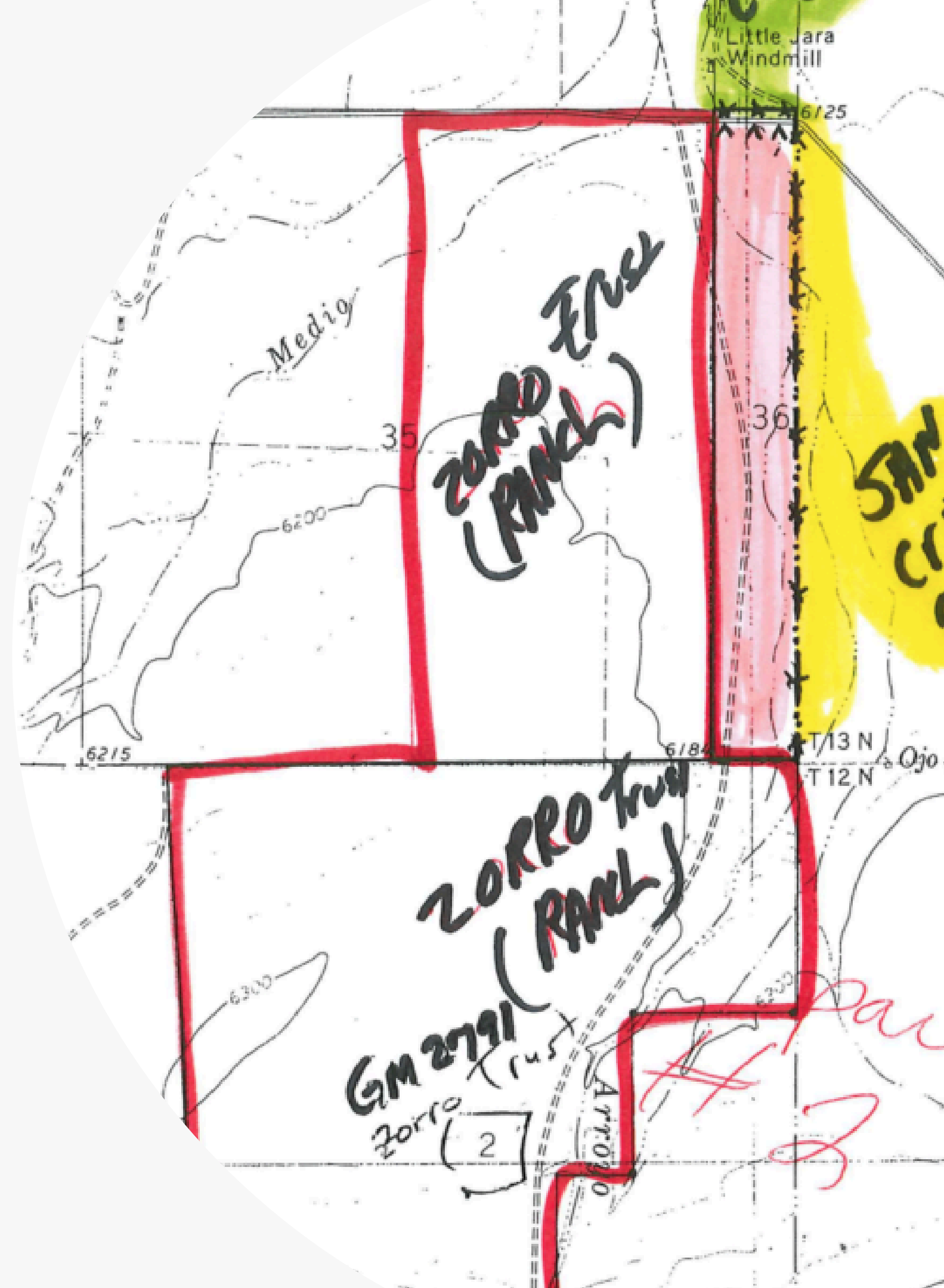
Zorro Ranch, New Mexico

Cross-Jurisdiction & International

trafficking networks & flight logs

Where crimes were enabled or designated elsewhere, we document what should have been charged — and transmit that record to the relevant authorities. We will recognize charges that should have been brought, organized by jurisdiction.

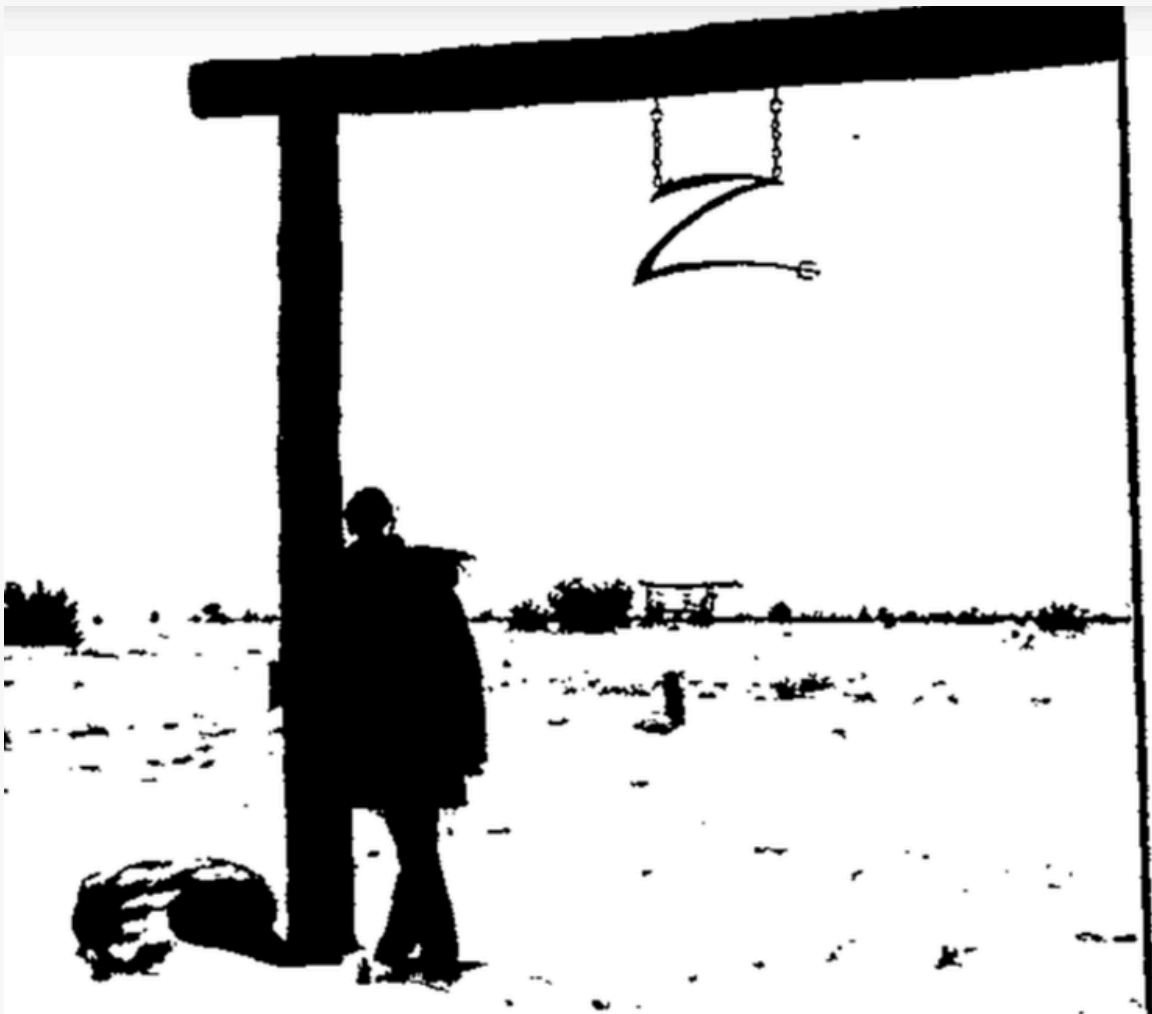

The Truth Commission is Dedicated to Protecting Survivors

All testimony provided to the Truth Commission will be:

- **Voluntary** - No survivor is compelled to testify
- **Uninterrupted** - Full narrative without cross-examination
- **Trauma-Informed** - Trained facilitators present at all sessions
- **Protected** - Testify publicly, on camera, or in writing
- **Official Record** - Formally transcribed & entered into Commission record

COMMISSION PROCESS

Site & Physical Evidence

- Physical search of Zorro Ranch
- Issuing of subpoenas to all known perpetrators and institutions for information
- Property records & estate review and preserve at-risk evidence and testimony

Source Development & Evidentiary Review

- Review tips & attorneys for victims - nmtruthcommission.com
- Secure law enforcement & AG files
- Interviewing witness list
- AI-assisted document review

Findings & Public Reporting

- Name abusers, enablers, and co-conspirators
- Formal prosecutorial referrals
- Legislative reform recommendations
- Public survivor record

Justice, Healing & Reform

- **Legal & Prosecutorial Aims** - Criminal prosecution referrals to NM, FL, NY, USVI, international jurisdictions for civil damage claims against the Epstein estate and charging framework for uncharged conduct by jurisdiction.
- **Survivor Support & Community Response** - Counseling, legal advocacy and financial assistance, inclusive of resources for domestic violence, sexual violence, trafficking.
- **Institutional Reforms** - Sex offender registry reform; statute of limitations reform — childhood sexual abuse; screening for state land leasing by registered offenders; law enforcement: mandatory survivor-crediting protocols; and Jurisdictional management – preemption issues
- **Public Accountability** - Naming public officials involved — abusers, enablers, obstructors; transmit findings to international bodies; full public report, redacted only for prosecution or survivor safety
